#### Description of Contents

Items in Box 5 are the **correspondence of Capt John A F Jenkins** of the Union Steam Ship Company (Private address 14 Lochiel Rd, Remuera) on the subject of seabirds, particularly those observed during his voyages. These letters to John Jenkins are often in response to one he had written whose content can be gauged from the reply. The letters are in ring-binders.

#### Item Description

## 1) Royal Naval Bird Watching Society Correspondence, 1956-1988

Letters concerned with JJ's RNBWS membership and with the Society's journal 'Sea Swallow' The first letter (18 Feb 1956) from the RNBWS Chairman, Capt GS Tuck, mentions that Merchant Service personnel will be permitted to join. That of 16 Mar 1956 acknowledging Capt Jenkins membership is from the Society's Secretary CE Smith, HMS Ceres, Wetherby, Yorkshire. JJ appears to have rejoined in 1961 and then remained an active member. Some letters relate to his publications in Sea Swallow and to his work in preparing an index of the journal (ca. 1985).

## 2) Folder 2: Correspondence, 1961-1983

Letters to John Jenkins on ornithological matters from many authors (some being eminent figures in OSNZ), chiefly post-1979. The opening letter (16 July 1961) is from RB Sibson, advising how to go about joining OSNZ.

## 3) Folder 3: Correspondence, 1983-1988

Further letters to JJ on ornithological topics.

## 4) Australian Seabird Group and Wildlife Service

Correspondence, 1971-1983:

Letters to JJ on ornithological matters in the purview of these bodies. The first letter (25 Nov 1971) refers to the idea of forming ASG; followed by an invitation to join (5 Dec 1971). Another reports the inaugural meeting on 1 Oct 1972 at the Australian Museum, Sydney.

Further letters from museum sources. Ends with a letter from the Executive Officer of Fiji Museum (27 June 1988) addressed simply to 'John' 14 Lochiel Road, Remuera, seeking his surname and noting that Fergus Clunie, JJ's previous correspondent had left to live in New Zealand.

Items 1 to 3 comprise documents from OSNZ annual accounts and Treasurer's reports during the years 1955-1984. Particular Treasurers concerned are Mike Hogg and later Graeme Peterson. Expenses of publishing the journal Notornis are included.

Items 4 to 8 are regional reports and correspondence between OSNZ Secretaries (particularly Sandy Edgar, Brian Ellis and Peter Gaze) and the Society's Regional Representatives, as amplified below.

Most material relates to the years 1967 to 1980 with a few earlier or later documents.
