


OSNZ National Wader Census  
November – December 2010 & February - March 2011

A total of 159,111 waders of 25 species were counted during the November and December 2010 census. This is the third highest November count behind the 1994 total of 192,762 and 1995's 166,829. There was very good national coverage this time with only Gisborne/Wairoa, Lake Wairarapa and the Chatham's not counted. Semipalmated Plover, which was added to the list in June 2010, was seen again in November. 1 Grey Plover, 1 Siberian Tattler, 2 Large Sand Dotterels and 2 Hudsonian Godwits made up the other rarities.

Of the main species Bar-tailed Godwit led the way with 101,459, the second highest count, eclipsing the 1994 count of 101,189 but not the 1988 count of 101,771. There have been big fluctuations in godwit numbers since 1999, with a steady decline from 87,261 in 1999 to a low of 48,989 in 2004 before a steady climb back to the 2010 total. Full nationwide coverage did not occur in all years, which will account for some of the variation.



Lesser Knot numbers show a steady decline since the first national count in 1983 and this disturbing trend is probably set to continue with

serious loss of habitat happening at their major northward staging sites in China's Bohai Sea.


