Nelson, Rabbit I., 1 in weak condition early May, died several days later (HH). Manuka Bay, 1 moulting on open grassy slope on 19/2 (EBS). Bank's Pen, 40 birds including 12 prs present over summer: 3 at Lucas Bay, 1 at Grasshills Bay, 1 at Dan Roger's Crk, 1 at Damon's Bay, 9 at Stony Bay, 5 at Otanerito Bay, 11 at Gough's Bay, 6 at Hickory Bay; 4 breeding ads were banded at Otago Pen (PJD). Otago Pen 180-200 prs; Catlins 120-130 prs in Oct (JTD). Rangatira I., Chathams, 1 on 7-14/7/86 (CMM).

## BLUE PENGUIN Eudyptula minor

Nelson, usual widespread coastal records. Havelock to Port Ligar, odd individuals plus group of 3 on 14/4 (PAL). West Coast, common and breeding in many places including Charleston (KS), Whitehorse, Arahura (RS). Sumner, 1 on 11/10. Onawe Pen, no sign of nesting on 20/8. Outer Akaroa Hbr, 10-15 on 26/8 (PAL). Long B, c.20 nests in Dec (PS). Pilots B, Otago Pen 1 nest on 20/8 (ARB). Big South Cape I., 21 km sth, 2 on 30/11/85 (CMM).

Southland Coast, few grounded birds or corpses on beaches during outward migration April/May (MLB,BM). Mason Bay, Stewart I., 612 dead and dying on 10-11/5 after several days of strong westerlies (AA).

Inner Marlborough Sounds, c.100 with White-fronted Terns on 16/4. Kenepuru Sound to Rangitoto I., frequently seen, some groups 100 + birds on 14-16/4 (PAL). Lawyers Hd, Dunedin, c.120 offshore on 6/7/86 (AJDT).

HUTTON'S SHEARWATER P. huttoni

Open Bay I., 1 offshore on 6/8/85 (CMM).

LITTLE SHEARWATER P. assimilis

Pitt Str, Chathams, 1 on 7/7/86 (CMM).

Granite Ck, Kongahu, West Coast, 1 on 3/11 (NR). Rangatira I., Chathams, 3 on 9/7/86, 1 on 10/7/86 (CMM).

AUSTRALASIAN GANNET Sula bassana serrator

Nelson, frequently seen in Tasman and Golden Bays. Farewell Spit, breeding this season reduced by high tides with wind washing out part of colony, no full count (JMH). Havelock to Rangitoto I., individual ads frequent, 14-16/4 (PAL). Tauranga Bay, West Coast, 1 on 15/12 (KS,DJO). Seal I., 16 on 6/12 (KS). Punakaiki, 1 on 3/1 (CSL). Canterbury coast, 5 sightings of 1–2 ad during Aug & Sep (PAL). Manuka Bay, 5 on 11/1. Hurunui R mouth, 1 on 9/1. Pegasus Bay, more frequently seen and in larger numbers than in previous years, eg Amberley B, 24 resting on water on 3/3; Ashley Est, 2 on 4/7, 1 juv on 7/4; Sth New Brighton, 1 on 2/12, 5 ad, 4 juv on 3/4; Scarborough, 21 ad, 5 juv on 4/4 (AC). Oreti B, nth end, equidistant (120 km) from Little Solander and Nuggets gannetries, 1 dead immature on 15/4, the first found here in 20 yrs of beach patrolling (RRS).

Otago region, 3 known breeding colonies: Maukiekie I., Nth Otago, 400 nests but decreasing; Taiaroa Hd, Otago Pen, c.100 nests; Green I., nr Waldronville, Dunedin, c.200 nests (PS). High Rock, Stewart I., 44 nests on 27/11/85 (CMM).

#### CHATHAM ISLAND SHAG L. carunculatus onslowi



Born at Griffithstown, John Jenkins attended West Monmouth Grammar School and began his sea-training at the Cardiff Navigation School. As a junior officer he served with the Deane Shipping Company and the Blue Star Line, making many voyages, especially to South America. Later in life he was wont to regret the opportunities he missed because in his early days at sea he had not developed what was to become an absorbing interest in marine ornithology.
