CLASSIFIED SUMMARISED NOTES, NORTH ISLAND 1 JULY 1989 TO 30 JUNE 1990

Classified Summarised Notes (CSN) are a selection of observations provided by 211 members and friends of the Ornithological Society of New Zealand. This year observations were received from all but two regions (Taranaki and Wanganui), and in addition, eight members provided individual contributions. The level of support for CSN is slightly down on last year with fewer records from Auckland and South Auckland. In particular, census counts of common species of wading bird in the Manukau Harbour and Firth of Thames were not provided this year. However, large and detailed contributions were reported by Hawke's Bay and Bay of Plenty regions. A significant contribution was provided by Janet Houston, who collected systematic observations of seabirds from a fishing boat in the Bay of Plenty. This will increase our knowledge of the annual patterns of many pelagic seabirds.

The format of CSN this year follows the new 1990 Checklist of the Birds of New Zealand. All records from kiwi to gamebirds plus skuas, gulls and terns were collated by GAT, and rails, waders and pigeons to passerines were collated by GRP.

BROWN KIWI Apteryx australis mantelli

[N] Waipoua ŠF, Kauri Sanctuary, several heard calling and probes found next to hut on 8-9/5; Pukenui Forest, Whangarei, 3 males calling on 25/1, 1 dead female (killed by dog) found on track on 26/1 (PA). L Tahora, 1 heard on 14/4 (P&KM). [VP] Kaimanawa SFP, 1 heard near confluence of Tauranga-Taupo R and Cascade Stm on 20/1 (TAS).

LITTLE SPOTTED KIWI A. owenii

[N] Hen I, 1 on 23/5, 800 m ENE of lighthouse at 2220 h (P&KM).

[N] L Rehutai, Dargaville, 2 on 25/2; dune lake 2-3 km north of Round Hill, 1 pair + 2 juvs on 28/10; lake west of Kaipara Lighthouse, 23 on 25/3 (P&KM). L Humuhumu, Poutu, 5+ on 19/4 (RJP). [A] L Kereta, Kaipara South Head, 16 adults + 2 small chicks on 2/9 (PFB, AJT, PS, CJ). [Wk] Whitehall, near Cambridge, I on farm dam, early to late May (TBT). Cambridge SP, 5 on 17/5 (BHS). [BP] Matata Lag, 2-4 on main lagoon between 30/1 and 2/6 (PCL, AM, AJT, RMW), 2 on 30/6 (P&KM). Kawerau, 2 on 23/7 on small lake on Maori Affairs farm opposite Tasman Pulp and Paper Co's mill (RMW). AUSTRALASIAN LITTLE GREBE Tachybaptus novaehollandiae

[N] Ngapuhi, near Kaikohe, 4 including 1 juv on large pond on 24/6; Kauri, near Whangarei, 5 in Jan, pair only in Feb, nesting on lilies (RJP). L Owhareiti, near Kaikohe, 1 pair on 6/6 (PA). Round Hill, dune lake 2-3 km north, 1 pair on 28/10 (P&KM). [A] L Kereta, South Kaipara, 1 on 3/7 (VJL) and 29/7 (GAP).

WANDERING ALBATROSS Diomedea exulans

[BP] Halfway to Mayor I from Mt Maunganui, 1 imm (all brown but for white face and underwing) on 25/4 (JEH). Plate I, 1 adult offshore on 2/9 (PCL). [W] Cook Strait, 1 stage 3 plumage on 25/12 (AJT), 1 full adult plumage on 2/1 (IS).

BLACK-BROWED MOLLYMAWK D. melanophrys

[BP] Off Mayor I, (usually midway Mayor I and Mt Maunganui) 1 or 2 imms on 7 visits between 8/6/89 and 12/8, 3 imms on 2/9 and 12/9, singles on 24/9, 28/9, 10/10 and 14/10, 2 imms on 18/10 and 21/10. Another 6 visits were made from 22/10 to 31/10 with max of 8 (all imm) on 29-31/10, these birds were hungry enough to come and feed at the boatside. Birds seen on each of 5 visits during Nov, max 3 imms. Six visits were made in Dec with max 7 imms on 20/12. In Jan, single imm birds noted on 7-8/1. No further sightings until 25/4 when 1 adult "impavida' and 1 imm were seen. In May, 1 imm on 6/5 and 2 on 13/5 (JEH). Off Motiti I, 1-3 imms on 7 visits between 10/5/89 and 9/8, single imms on 19/10 and 4/11, 4 imms on 21/11, 1 adult "impavida" and 1 imm on 5/6, 1 imm on 30/6 (JEH). [HB] Napier B, 1 adult on 5/1 (IS). [W] Cook Strait, 1 adult on 6/8 (IS), 2 imms with dusky bills, without collar, 1 with grey underwing, other whiter on 25/12 (AJT), 2 adults on Ferry crossing on 16/6 (GAT, IS, AJT, PFB).

WHITE-CAPPED MOLLYMAWK D. cauta

[BP] Off Mayor I, 1 adult on 29/10 and 10/1 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, 4 passing north on 23/12 (JLM). [W] Cook Strait, 2 adults on 25/12 (AJT, AD), c.50 seen on Ferry crossings on 16/6 (PFB, AJT, IS, GAT).

GREY-HEADED MOLLYMAWK D. chrysostoma [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 imm on 15/7 (JEH).

YELLOW-NOSED MOLLYMAWK D. chlororhynchos

[SA] Whitianga, 1 offshore on 5/7 (N.Hopkins per AJT), 1 white-headed bird offshore on 18/7 (AJT, TGL, GAT). Whangamata, 1 found dead on beach on 7/10 (HS). [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 adult on 9/7, 4 adults and 1 imm on 15/7, 1 or 2 birds were seen each visit on 16/7, 25/7 and 12/8, 1 adult on 12/9 then no more sightings until 1 adult on 13/5 and 1 imm on 22/5; Off Motiti I, 2 adults and 1 imm on 5/7, 1 adult on 18/7, 1 imm on 15/5 and 31/5, 1 adult on 30/6 (JEH).

BULLER'S MOLLYMAWK D. bulleri

[W] Cook Strait, 1 on 16/6 (AJT, GAT, PFB, IS).

LIGHT-MANTLED SOOTY ALBATROSS Phoebetria palpebrata

[SA] Whitianga, 1 found alive on beach, it died later on 6/10 (HS). [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 adult on 1/8 (JEH). Mt Maunganui, 1 dead on beach on 4/10 (KF). [Wr] Ahikouka Rd, north of Greytown, 1 grounded after storms in early June, later released successfully at Castlepoint (DW, MW). Tauherenikau Racecourse, another bird found near here in very poor condition and later died (DMS). Cape Palliser, two sightings of single bird on 17/6 and 20/6 from fishing boat c3 km offshore (AGS).

ALBATROSS/MOLLYMAWK sp.

[A] South of Little Barrier I, 1 on 23/4, possibly a Grey-headed but too distant to confirm ID (ASR, PS, TCG).

FLESH-FOOTED SHEARWATER Puffinus carneipes

[A] Pakiri B, 1 freshly dead bird ashore on 1/10 (CJ, SPC). Kauwahaia I, Te Henga, 1 ashore on 19/12 (GAT, KS), 7 on 31/1 including pairs in burrows (AJT, GAT). [BP] Off Mayor I, none seen after 13/5/89 until first sighting for new season on 24/9 (JEH), c10 on 30/9 (RSC). Birds then seen in varying numbers on virtually all visits to Mayor I and Motiti I up to 27/4, after that single birds only seen on 1/5 and 13/5. On 25/4 and 27/4, up to 30 very hungry birds gathered to feed on scraps about the boat (JEH). [G/W] Tolaga Bay, c50 km offshore, feeding flock built up to 130 birds from 0900 to 1300 hours on 16/4, feeding on saury in association with dolphins and tuna (GAF).

BULLER'S SHEARWATER P. bulleri

[FN] Motuopao I, Cape Maria Van Diemen, birds flying past all day on 6-10/10 and 1-3/2 (GRP, RJP, PA). Cape Maria Van Diemen, 300 per minute passing on 2/11 with lesser numbers of Flesh-footed and Fluttering Shearwaters (PFB, ACC). Motu Purihi I, Simmonds group, near Houhora, 1 adult and chick in burrow on 25/1, the first breeding record for this species away from the Poor Knights group (GRP, BW). [N] Aorangi I, Poor Knights, many fully grown young ashore in burrows on 17/5 (RJP). [A] South of Little Barrier I, lots of Buller's on 23/4 (ASR, TCG, PS). [BP] Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, none seen after sighting on 19/5/89 until 1 off Mayor I and another at Astrolabe Reef near Motiti on 12/9 (the first sightings for the new season), a few at Astrolabe Reef on 16/9 (JEH), 2 on 17/9 (BHS), plenty seen off Mayor I by 24/9 (JEH), 2 on 30/9 (RSC). Birds were seen on nearly all of c50 subsequent visits to these waters from 30/9 to 15/5, the last sightings being single birds off Pudney Rock on 10/5, off Mayor I on

12/5 and off north end of Motiti I on 15/5 (JEH). [G/W] Lottin Pt, hundreds flying eastwards offshore (10-20 seen at one time) on 1-2/1 (GAT). Tolaga Bay, up to 20 birds seen each day between 8 and 50 km offshore from 0900 to 1300 hours on 14-16/4. 3 birds joined in with Flesh-footed Shearwaters, dolphins and tuna feeding on saury (GAF).

SOOTY SHEARWATER P. griseus

[FN] Motuopao I, off Cape Maria Van Diemen, a few occupied burrows on 1-3/2 (GRP, RJP, PA). [A] Northeast of Hen I, 1 on 13/4; North of Great Barrier I, 1 on 16/4 (AJT, GAT, TGL). Between Little and Great Barrier Is, 1 seen at sea on 12/10 (GAT, AJT). Kauwahaia I, Te Henga, birds sitting on eggs on 8/12 (GAT, AJT, GJE). [BP] Mt Maunganui to Mayor I, none from 13/5/89 until a few off Astrolabe Reef on 16/9 and off Mayor I on 24/9. On 30/9 there was a continuous stream of Sootys, along with a few Fleshfooted, flying southeast from Astrolabe Reef. Birds were abundant off Motiti on 1/10. Single birds seen off Motiti on 4/11 and 21/11 and off Mayor I on 17/2 and 3/1, then none seen until 6/5 when 1 or 2 were off Pudney Rock. Last sightings were 1 off Pudney Rock on 10/5, 1 off Mayor I on 13/5 and 1 at Astrolabe Reef on 18/5 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, 3 passing north on 13/1 (JLM).

SHORT-TAILED SHEARWATER P. tenuirostris

[BP] Off Motiti I, 1 bird only, fed scraps and observed closely on 6/3 (JEH). [W] Waikanae B, 1 live with broken leg on 11/11, it ate 40-50 fish, only taking whole "herrings" 5-10 cm head first while it refused other fish, released on 12/11 (BAT).

FLUTTERING SHEARWATER P. gavia

[FN] Motuopao I, off Cape Maria Van Diemen, numerous offshore on 1-3/2 (GRP, RJP, PA). Motu Purihi I, Simmonds group, 1 ashore and 2 flying around on 25/1 (GRP, BW). [N] Whangarei H, between Marsden and McLeod Bays, c20,000 in a huge flock, actively feeding on 4/3 (GRP). Bream Bay, c8000 in outer waters on 13/4 (GAT, TGL, AJT). [A] Little Barrier I, 1 heard aerial calling over Te Titoki Pt flat on 21/9 and 23-27/5 (AJT, TCG, PS, MD). Lot's Wife, off Little Barrier I, 1 female on fresh egg on 17/9 (AJT, TCG). Saddle I, off Great Barrier I, 3 ashore on 14-15/4, many disused burrows present; Stack south-west of Opakau I, ground densely burrowed by this species, many white feathers in entrances on 15/4 (TGL, GAT, AJT). Mahurangi H, c4500 in entrance on 28/2 (AJT). Maria I, I caught on surface, others heard calling in flight on 25/11 (GAT, RIP). Whatipu B, c2000 offshore on 1/8 (GAT, AJT). [SA] Papaaroha, Coromandel Pen, 280 + very close inshore on 22/1 (EP). [BP] Mayor I to Motiti I, present throughout the year, seen in varying numbers on most visits to area from May '89 to May '90 (JEH). Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, c65 on 17/9 (BHS). [G/W] Lottin Pt, many hundreds flying offshore, heading eastwards on 1-2/1 with Buller's Shearwaters (GAT, SLT). Tolaga Bay, up to 10 birds seen each day, up to 50 km offshore on 14-16/4 (GAF). Pukenui B, huge flock of 2500-3000 + feeding over school of kahawai offshore on 4/1 (GAT, SLT).

[M] Foxton B, max c5000 per hour passing south on 30/12 (JLM). [W] Seas north of Kapiti I, c40 on 14/1 (AJT). Breaker Bay, Wellington H, c180 roosting in flock on 10/4 (GAT).

HUTTON'S SHEARWATER P. huttoni

[G/W] Tolaga Bay, c200 birds feeding and resting 7 km offshore on 17/3 (GAF).

LITTLE SHEARWATER P. assimilis

[N] Hen I, a few coming ashore at night on 22-26/5 (P&KM). [A] Between Hen I and Mokohinau I, 2 at sea on 13/4, 3 on 16/4; Northwest of Great Barrier I, 2 on 16/4 (AJT, GAT, TGL). [SA] Stanley I, Mercury group, 1 with palpable egg in abdomen ashore on 17/7; 1 incubating egg on 19/8 (GAT). [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 on 29/10 (JEH). [G/W] Tolaga Bay, 1 bird passing 7 km offshore on 17/3; c10 sightings of birds 40 km offshore between 0900 - 1300 hours on 16/4, 3 the most seen together (GAF).

DIVING PETREL Pelecanoides urinatrix

[FN] Motuopao I, off Cape Maria Van Diemen, c100-200 pairs estimated over 3 trips (Oct-Feb), present also on adjacent stack (GRP). [N] Aorangi I, Poor Knights, many adults ashore at night on 17/5 (RJP). [A] Mangawhai B, large wreck of Diving Petrels present on 1/10. These included 1 bird banded on 18/8 as a breeding adult on Outer Stack, Stanley I – a movement of 126 km (SLT, GAT). Groper Rock, Mokohinau group, 1 bird called from burrow by day on 16/4, burrows very dense, probably several thousand present (GAT, AJT, SAn). Lot's Wife, off Little Barrier I, 1 in burrow by day and broken egg found on surface on 17/9 (AJT, TCG). Stack southwest of Opakau I, remains of 2 dead birds found under taupata on 15/4 (TGL). Tiritiri Matangi I, 1 large downy chick in burrow at north end of island on 20/11 (AJT, PS). Maria I, 1 caught, others calling from nearby burrows on 25/11 (GAT, RJP). Kauwahaia I, Te Henga, 1 with bare brood patch found ashore and several others seen in flight on 21/9 (GAT, SD, SLT); several preyed on corpses found in Dec, probably killed by ship rats (GAT, AJT). [SA] Mercury Is, 1000's offshore on 18/7 (AJT, GAT, TGL). [BP] Mayor I to Motiti I, numerous on most visits to area from May '89 to Aug '89 (JEH), numerous on 27/10 about Penguin Shoals but then found to be scarce until 26/3 when they were numerous off Mayor I. They were abundant in the vicinity of Motiti I throughout May and off Mayor I on 13/5 (JEH). Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, c34 on 17/9 (BHS), a large flock was seen c5 km offshore on 22/5 (JEH). [W] Cook Strait, birds frequent off Wellington H to Tory Channel on 16/6 (GAT, AJT, PFB, IS).

BLACK PETREL Procellaria parkinsoni

[BP] Off Mayor I, single bird was fed on fish scraps close to boat on 17/12, then 3 on 29/12. Birds were seen on 9 of 14 subsequent visits to area during Feb to April, the last date any were seen being 28/4 when 4 (max seen at one time) were fed scraps by the boat (JEH).

WESTLAND PETREL P. westlandica

[W] Cook Strait, c12 probables seen from Ferry crossings on 16/6 (AJT, IS, GAT, PFB).

CAPE PIGEON Daption capense

[FN] Taheke Rock, Cavalli I, 1 on 10/6 (AW). [BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, 1 or 2 birds on each of 10 visits between 22/7 and 27/10 (JEH, RSC), 1 on 3/6 (JEH). [W] Cook Strait, c6 on Ferry crossing on 16/6 (PFB, AJT, GAT, IS).

NORTHERN GIANT PETREL Macronectes halli

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, singles seen on 20 visits to these waters between 29/6/89 and 4/11, 2 on 16/9 was only occasion with more than one seen. In many cases, these birds were hungry and could be hand fed from the boat. Single birds on 20/12 and 24/12 then none until 1 on 3/6 off Mayor I and 1 on 10/6 off Motiti I (IEH).

GIANT PETREL sp.

[A] West of Great Barrier I, 4 dark with pale faces on 12/10 (AJT, GAT). [BP] Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, 1 on 17/9 (BHS). [M] Moanaroa B, 1 imm flying close to shore on 13/8 (IS). FAIRY PRION Pachyptila turtur

[N] Aorangi I, Poor Knights, a few ashore at night on 17/5 (RJP). [A] South of Little Barrier I, 1 on 23/4 (ASR, TCG, PS). [BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, numerous on most visits during July, small numbers of prions, probably "turtur", recorded on visits in each month from Aug to Dec and again in May; Astrolabe Reef, very numerous on 5/6 (JEH). [M] Moanaroa B, 1 over land on 22/12 (IS). [W] Cook Strait, many thousands (5000+) from ferry on 2/1 (IS).

THIN-BILLED PRION P. belcheri

[A] Muriwai B, 1 alive on 9/7 (AJT et al.).

BROAD-BILLED PRION P. vittata

[SA] Mercer, hills above town, 1 on 18/12 found inside a house, being watched over by cat. Many lice on head and body. Strong west wind overnight. Released from boat at Kaiaua (DAL). [BP] Ohope B, 1 exhausted bird picked up still alive on 15/6, it died later (WMH).

PRION sp.

[M] Foxton B, 3 passing north on 23/12 (JLM).

COOK'S PETREL P. cookii

[A] Little Barrier I, none heard at night 12-15/9, first heard 16/9, many more by 17/9, a few "kek-kek" calls heard on 21/5 (AJT, KBr, RB). War-whoops were tried near the summit and on flat just after their return but with no success. However, 1 was landed from flight by the bunkhouse

using this method + torches on 16/12, a night of light wind and low cloud (TCG). Kauwahaia I, Te Henga, 1 heard to give a short burst of kek-kek calls, flying high over the coast about 40 minutes after sunset on 13/12 (GAT, EKC). [A] Great Barrier I: stack off Wood I, pair + 1 single in 4 burrows during day on 14/4 (new breeding locality); Saddle I, estimated 50-100 burrows present, many occupied on 14/4; Stack south-west of Opakau I, 1 adult ashore in burrow and c3-6 burrows found on 15/4; Islet off 'Man of War' Passage, c12 called in response to war-whoops on larger islet, none heard on neighbouring islands on 14/4 (TGL, AJT, GAT). Little Barrier I, at least 3 birds calling at night in response to war-whoops at Pa to north of Te Titoki Pt and 2 birds caught on 21/5, first records for many years (AJT, PS). Waitakere Coast, West Auckland, active colonies of c200 pairs (SD). Cornwallis, heard several at night on southwest side of peninsula on 25/4 (AJT, NR, GJE). [SA] Stanley I, Mercury group, 1 chick c5 days old, 1 pipping egg and 9 birds incubating eggs in sample of 43 burrows on 21/8 (GAT, AJT). [BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, a few near Astrolabe Reef on 5/7, several off Mayor I on 1/8, several between Mt Maunganui and Motiti on 9/8, 13/8 and 6/9, no more seen until 1 on 28/4 off Mayor I, several off Motiti on 3/5, 1 at Pudney Reef on 6/5, several off Mayor I on 19/5 and a few off Motiti on 29/5; Mt Maunganui, 1 at sea a few km offshore on 20/6 (JEH), 1 blown ashore during northerly storm on 18/1 then released later, another on 22/1 (PCL), 10 birds banded at night on Mt Maunganui on 2/6; Ohope Ridge, c20 calls heard at night at western end of town as birds flying to coastal hills on 2/6; Whitianga Bay, near Motu R, c12 seen and heard at night on point at southern end on 2/6 (AJT).

WHITE-HEADED PETREL P. lessonii [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 on 1/8 (JEH).

WILSON'S STORM PETREL Oceanites oceanicus

Seven sightings were made in April and 1 in May of birds flying north. These observations and others made in previous years suggest that this species may be a regular passage migrant through east coast waters in late autumn (GAT). WHITE-BELLIED STORM PETREL Fregetta grallaria

BLUE PENGUIN Eudyptula minor

[N] Hen I to Whangarei Heads, c50 on 1/4 (GRP, TS). [A] Groper Rock, Mokohinau I, 5 empty burrows on 16/4 (AJT, GAT). Goat I, 1 mid-moult predated with rear of skull opened on 25/3 (AJT). South of Little Barrier I, very few present on 23/4 (ASR, TCG, PS). Maria I, several ashore on 25/11 (GAT, RJP, SM, SLT). Mercer's Bay, north of Karekare B, several sites had been used for moulting on 8/4 (AJT). [BP] Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, c50 on 17/9 (PCL). Off Motiti I, penguins "all over the place" on 9/4 (JEH). [HB] Napier, 1 calling under jetty at Napier Yacht Club on 26/5 (JW). Known to be around Napier H but not often seen or heard (MTC).

RED-TAILED TROPICBIRD Phaethon rubricauda

One adult at sea 38°46'S, 159°57'E from "Rainbow Warrior" on 11/1 (B. Deeble per AJT). [A] Muriwai B, 1 recently dead bird ashore in slightly worn juv plumage, also 2 moulted adult primaries from different birds on 6/5 (AJT, GJE).

AUSTRALASIAN GANNET Morus serrator

[N] Pinnacles, Poor Knights, several hundred nest building on 18/5 (RJP). [A] Cathedral Rocks, Mokohinau Is, c200 including 9 juvs on 16/4 (TGL, AJT, GAT). [VP] Pureora HQ, 1 on 23/9 (BHS). Kaimanawa SFP, 7 near confluence of Tauranga-Taupo R and Cascade Stm on 20/1 (TAS). [G/W] Urewera NP, a few heard around L Waikareiti and L Ruapane on 8-9/5 (GRP). [HB] Kuripapango Ls, at least 3 on 14/4 and also on 25/4; Blowhard Bush, 1 on 14/4 (CFM, JGH).

SILVEREYE Zosterops lateralis

[A] Groper Rock, Mokohinau I, 2 dead on 16/4 (AJT, GAT). Wenderholm, Waiwera, several feeding from puriri flowers from 21/3 to 27/4, 1 eating totara fruit on 30/3, several eating flesh from ripe kohekohe fruit on 18/5; Birkenhead, Auckland, several eating ripe kahikatea fruit from 18/2 to 12/4 (AJT). [SA] Coromandel, Kaitarakihi Track, flocks moving through from 0730-0930 h, few heard during afternoon on 1/4 (AJG et al.). [VP] Titiraupenga Track, Pureora, big flocks feeding through trees on 22/9 (BHS). [HB] Taradale, birds feeding on crab-apple throughout July-Sept. Very severe winter, birds were hungry enough to keep feeding even when observer stood by tree. Up to 13 birds present at a time (ARG). Clive, 30-40 flying from oaks on 19/6 (KVT). Havelock North, birds feeding on feijoa flower petals in spring '89, also observed feeding chicks with petals (JRB). Fernhill, 2 nests in vineyard in early Dec (JGH). [W] Karori, Wellington, some eating flesh from cherry plum fruit on 10/6 (AJT).

BELLBIRD Anthornis melanura

[N] Kiripaka Bridge, 2 seen several times in Feb (DH). [A] Little Barrier I, 1 feeding from puriri flowers on 27-28/5 (AJT). [Wk] Mt Karioi, 1 in July (JMR). Oparau, heard on 4/8 (PMB). Mapara, abundant in full song, feeding on rata blooms in possum control areas (ASR). [G/W] Lottin Pt, loud morning chorus with many birds singing in flowering pohutukawas by coast on 2/1 (GAT, SLT). [HB] Kuripapango Ls, present on 14/4; Blowhard Bush, present on 14/4 (CFM, JGH).

TUI Prosthemadera novaeseelandiae

[FN] Moturoa I, BoI, 1 seen in late Jan, apparently uncommon (GAT). [A] Groper Rock, Mokohinau group, 1 adult and 2 juvs on 16/4, looking out of place as they foraged amongst iceplant mats near the shoreline + 1 freshly eaten bird (by Harrier?) (GAT, AJT, SAn). Little Barrier I, 1 eating Coprosma arborea fruit on 21/5 and 28/5, many eating mahoe fruit on 21-28/5, 1 feeding from puriri flowers on 27-28/5; Wenderholm, Waiwera, a few eating ripe kahikatea fruit on 10-27/4, a few feeding from puriri flowers on 11/4 to 8/5, 3 eating ripe kohekohe fruit on 27/4, several feeding from flame tree flowers on 7-18/5; Birkenhead, Auckland, 1 often eating ripe kahikatea fruit from 18/2 to 6/4 (AJT). [SA] Manurewa, 1 watched feeding on ripe fallen apple during April (PHd). [Wk] Mt Karioi, 1 in July (JMR). Mapara, abundant in full song feeding on rata blooms in possum control area, up to 30 to a clearing (ASR). [BP] Herepuru, 1 on 4/11 (RMW). Motu R bridge, 1 on 7/2 (PCL). [VP] Titiraupenga Track, Pureora, 2 on 22/9; Pureora HQ, 1 on 23/9 (BHS). [M] Bulls, 1 on 12/7 (well away from normal breeding area) (IS). [HB] Blowhard Bush, present on 14/4 (CFM, JGH). Havelock North, birds from Mohi Bush, Maraetotara began to arrive on c27/5 (FET).

Mohi Bush, Maraetotara, c200 birds in spring '89 (HAR). [W] Nga Manu, Waikanae, c10 on 9/1 (AJT, BAT).

YELLOWHAMMER Emberiza citrinella

[BP] Motu R mouth, 3 cocks on 7/2; Whangaparaoa R mouth, 2 on 7/2 (PCL).

CIRL BUNTING E. cirlus

[HB] Mangakuri B, 1 on 5/12 (BS).

CHAFFINCH Fringilla coelebs

[A] Grafton Gully, Auckland, 1 singing on 10/8 (MJT). Whatipu B, 13 males and 8 females in flock foraging over wet sand on 4/9 (GAT). [G/W] Te Araroa to East Cape, mixed flocks with Goldfinches and Yellowhammers of hundreds of birds on 3/6 (AJT). [HB] Taradale, 2 on 7/6 and 1 male on 27/6 in Hammond St garden, the first seen there during many years residence (ARG).

GREENFINCH Carduelis chloris

[BP] Matata, c20 feeding on boxthorn berries on 22/4 (PCL). [M] Whirokino, c500 on 10/3 (JLM). [HB] Meeanee, 100+ present with hundreds of Goldfinches on 24/1, in field covered with rotting apples. Birds return to this field every year (MPT, PWT). Hastings, city garden, 6-8 eating sunflower, apple, pear and kiwifruit seed through winter '90 (KVT).

GOLDFINCH C. carduelis

[A] Woodhill Forest, 1 eating puha seeds on 16/5 (AJT). [M] Manawatu E, c300 on 24/3 feeding on samphire (JLM). [HB] Hastings, city garden, cosmos and rosemary seeds eaten during autumn '90 (KVT).

REDPOLL C. flammea

[FN] Moturoa I, BoI, 2 singing in flight on 21/1 (GAT). [A] Whatipu B, c20 on 1/8 (AJT, GAT), 7 on 4/9 (AJT, GAT, KS). [VP] Kaimanawa SFP, present in May (TAS). [M] Otaki Forks, common in pine forest on 27/12 (AJT). [HB] Fernhill, nesting in vineyard in early Dec (JGH).

HOUSE SPARROW Passer domesticus

[A] Groper Rock, Mokohinau group, 6 on 16/4 (AJT, GAT, SAn). Wenderholm, Waiwera, 1 eating ripe totara fruit on 2/3; Birkenhead, Auckland, 1 eating ripe kahikatea fruit on 18/2 (AJT). [Wk] L Ngaroto, huge mixed flocks including Greenfinches, Goldfinches and Yellowhammers feeding among maize stubble (on weed seeds?) on 17/5 (BHS). [HB] Hastings, seen in city garden with greenfinches, cracking open sunflower seeds. Sparrows tried to take seeds from finches' bills, winter '90 (KVT).

STARLING Sturnus vulgaris

[A] Cathedral Rocks, Mokohinau Is, c15 on 16/4 (AJT), Groper Rock, Mokohinau Is, c20 on 16/4 (GAT, AJT, SAn). Lot's Wife, Little Barrier I, 1 on 20/9 (AJT, TCG). Birkenhead, Auckland, 1 eating ripe kahikatea fruit on 18/2 and 25/4 (AJT). [HB] Ahuriri E, huge flocks in conifers on 4/3 (MPT, PWT). Hastings, city garden, birds waiting from high vantage points each morning for bread and meat to appear on lawn, especially in winter (KVT).

COMMON MYNA Acridotheres tristis

[M] Bulls, 1 on 16/9, nearest birds normally Wanganui (IS). [W] Tawa, 1 from Jan '89 to June '90 (DS, MS).

NORTH ISLAND KOKAKO Callaeas cinerea wilsoni

[N] Matarau SF, 7 pairs found in survey during June-July (continuing) (RJP, PA, KBr, PM, NM). [Wk] Pirongia, Greys Rd end, 1 on 30/8 (BLP).

NORTH ISLAND SADDLEBACK Philesturnus carunculatus rufusater [A] Liitle Barrier I, 1 eating mahoe fruit on 21/5 (AJT).

AUSTRALIAN MAGPIE Gymnorhina tibicen

[A] Little Barrier I, Te Titoki flat, 2 on 12-23/9, 1 on 27/5 (AJT). [BP] Whale I, 4 on 21/2 (this is an addition to status and distribution of birds of the island published in Tane Vol. 17, 1971) (RMW). Rangitaiki R mouth, a flock of 25 on 2/6 (AJT).

ROOK Corvus frugilegus

[SA] Clevedon, 1 taken to roosting in the outskirts of village, being fed by locals, 2 on 15/8; Manurewa, 1 in paddock adjoining Botanical Gardens on 26/8 (ATC). Kopuku, 1 on 24/9 (PJA, DJA). Mangatangi township, 56 feeding in paddock on 7/7 (DAL). Miranda, 42 on 30/3 (BHS).
