Akaroa Hds, 2 offshore on 8/5 (PAL). Foveaux Str, very common on 11/12 (DH).

# SALVIN'S MOLLYMAWK D.cauta salvini

South Bay, Kaikoura, 50 + on 31/12 (IS). Foveaux Str, 1 on 11/12 (DH).

## ANTARCTIC FULMAR Fulmarus glacialoides

Blueskin Bay, 1 live bird collected on 9/10 and released same day at Taiaroa Hd (GL).

# GIANT PETREL Macronectes sp.

Akaroa Hds, 1 offshore on 8/5. Birdling's Flat, 1 feeding near surf zone on 19/11 (PAL). Rangatira I, Chatham Is, 1-5 seen daily 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D).

# CAPE PIGEON Daption capense

Akaroa Hds, 10-15 attracted to trawler on 8/5 (PAL). Otago Hbr, c.150 flying up harbour on 8/12 (LP).

# MOTTLED PETREL Pterodroma inexpectata

Codfish I, 24 of the 50 study burrows held chicks when checked in April (JW).

# COOK'S PETREL P.cookii

Codfish I, annual survey of known burrows in April produced 25 chicks, the best year so far for the study (JW).

# **BLACK-WINGED PETREL** *P.nigripennis*

Rangatira I, Chatham Is, 1 spotlighted down on the Clears on 1/4 (CFJO'D).

# CHATHAM PETREL P.axillaris

South East I, Chatham I, 5 burrows with incubating ads late Jan (RN,JW), 3 chicks only surviving late Mar (CFJO'D).

## FAIRY PRION Pachyptila turtur

Thousands off Nth Brothers I, on 10/11. Sentinel Rock, Cook Strait, c.1000 nearby on 11/1 (DB). Tasman Bay, 5 birds found exhausted inland in Feb, 4 later released (HH).

# BROAD-BILLED PRION P. vittata

North Brothers I, 1 found dead (hit lighthouse?) on 9/11 (DB). Tasman Bay, 2 found inland in early Dec, 1 later released (HH).

# FLESH-FOOTED SHEARWATER Puffinus carneipes

Arapawa I, 5 following fishing boat in Feb (DB). Stephens I, c.10 on 3/3 (PAL).

# SOOTY SHEARWATER P. bulleri

Motuanauru I, nesting in hundreds in Oct. Otuhaerera I, Croisilles Hbr, nesting in low numbers in Oct. Glasgow I, Cook Strait, small colony on 15/2 (DB). Akaroa Hds, 250 + in rafts on 28/4, many tens of thousands during 15 knot westerlies on 8/5 (PAL). Rangatira I, Chatham Is, only 1 juv seen out of burrows on 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D). Codfish I, chicks were found in April in 17 of the 50 study burrows (JW).

# FLUTTERING SHEARWATER P. gavia

Glasgow I, Cook Strait, small colony on 15/2. Forsyth Bay, Marlborough Sds, 2000 + on 22/3. Titirangi Bay, Marlborough Sds, 1000 + on 23/3. Admiralty Bay, hundreds feeding on crustacean krill on 7/4 (DB). Pelorus Sd to Stephens I, throughout in flocks up to c.75 on 3-4/3 (PAL).

# HUTTON'S SHEARWATER P. huttoni

Waipara RM, c.30 feeding in surf zone on 5/1 (AC).

## GREY-BACKED STORM PETREL Garrodia nereis Rangatira I, Chatham Is, 20 + seen each night 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D).

WHITE-FACED STORM PETREL Pelagodroma marina Rangatira I, Chatham Is, only 2 seen 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D).

#### **DIVING PETREL** Pelecanoides urinatrix

Jag Rock-Stephens I, low numbers on 3/3 (PAL). Tasman Bay, Nelson, birds found inland as far as St Arnaud after July wreck (OSNZ). Rangatira I, Chatham Is, max 2-11 seen each night on 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D).

#### KING PENGUIN Aptenodytes patagonicus

Kaikoura Coast, 5 km south of Waipapa Bay, 1 on 25/10 (BM). Caroline Bay, Timaru, 1 on beach 16-19/10 (DOC), 2nd and 3rd mainland NZ records.

#### YELLOW-EYED PENGUIN Megadyptes antipodes

Kempe Pt, outer Queen Charlotte Sd, 1 in water with metal band on right flipper on 13/5 (DB). Torrent Bay, Abel Tasman NP, 1 seen 200 m offshore on 27/1 (IM). Stoney Bay, Bank's Pen, 7 ad on 30/11, 2 chicks fed at nest site (KCH,SP). Lucas Bay, Akaroa Hbr, 1 ad on 28/4 (PAL). Rangatira I, Chatham Is, 1 present 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D). Centre I, Foveaux Str, 3 on 26/10, no sign of nesting (WJC).

#### BLUE PENGUIN Eudyptula minor

Outer Marlborough Sds, Richmond Bay to Jag Rocks, c.400 in groups of 5-40 birds on 3/3 (PAL). Motunau I, low chick production during 89/90 c.370 chicks banded compared with average of c.550 between 1980 and 1989 (CNC). Centre I, Foveaux Str, 5 nests each with 2 eggs on 26/10 (WJC).

#### **ROCKHOPPER PENGUIN** Eudyptes chrysocome

Auckland Is, 886 in 9 colonies on 1-2/1. Includes one colony on Adams I but Disappointment I colony not visited. Even allowing for many nesting birds not counted, a marked decline from the population of 10 000 estimated in 1972-73 was evident (WJC).

#### FIORDLAND CRESTED PENGUIN Eudyptes pachyrhynchus

Blaketown B, 4 on 12-26/12 (CSL). Murphy's B, breeding mid Sept. Jackson Bay, 1 on 23/6. Barn Bay, 1 on 12/12 (AA).

#### AUSTRALASIAN GANNET Morus servator

Nelson, frequently seen in Tasman and Golden Bays. Farewell Spit breeding suffered from high tides again, c.800 nests in Sept, c.300 chicks fledged in Mar (JMH). Waimaru colony, Pelorus Sd, c.100 ad on 5/9; 80 + ad, c.42 chicks on 5/1, 2 chicks still to fledge on 10/4 (DB). Pelorus Sd, groups up to 25 on 3-4/3 (PAL). Ashley Est, 2 on 5/7. New Brighton B, 1 on 7/5. Avon- Heathcote Est, 2 on 22/9. Whitewash Hd, 1 on 26/3 (AC). Bank's Pen, individual ads seen throughout year, 1 imm on 8/5 (PAL). 1991

Nelson, frequently seen in coastal areas and in numbers <10 at inland sites. Rangihaeata Hd, 86 on 6/2 (AC). Motueka Est, 116 including 20 juv on 24/7, 42 on 5/2 (AC,JMH). Pakiaka Pt Lgn, Croiselles Hbr, c.40 at colony on 15/10 (DB). Lewis R, 3 on 7/1. Occur in low numbers on the West Coast. L Ryan, 1 on 12/9, 28/10, 8/3. Range Crk Lgn, 1 on 13/2, 31/5. Grey R Est, 3 on 20/7, 1 on 11/1. Blaketown Lgn, 1 on 11/10, 6 + 1 juv on 13/2, 1 on 8/3, 3 on 5/4, 4 on 3/5. Karoro L, 3 on 13/2, 1 on 3/5. Taramakau R Est, 6 on 9/2, 4 on 20/3. Toaroha R, 1 on 26/10 (CSL). Avon-Heathcote Est, 200 + over summer (AC). Acheron R, colony of c.10 nesting in beech forest and on cliffs overlooking tarn on 7/1 (PAL). Selwyn Huts, L Ellesmere, 47 roosting in tall trees on 26/4 (KCH,SP). L Clearwater, 1 on 10/6 (PJH,JW).

## PIED SHAG P.varius

Nelson, Best's I colony still present. Rocks Rd colony declining, Haulashore I colony expanding (JMH). Pakiaka Pt Lgn, Croiselles Hbr, c.30 with 18 nests on 15/10. Lucerne Bay, Tennyson Inlet, 8 birds at nests on 17/1 (DB). Motunau, 70 at colony (55 ad, 15 imm) on 20/1 (PAL). Bromley SP, newly established colony of 8-10 nests alongside nesting Black Shags; 60 + birds present summer and autumn. Often seen feeding several km up Avon R but most feed on Avon-Heathcote Est and Pegasus Bay (AC). Little Akaloa, Bank's Pen, 1 on 20/8/88 (PAL). L Wainono, 1 found dead on 17/6 indicates birds are probably moving much further south than previously (AC,PR).

#### LITTLE BLACK SHAG P. sulcirostris

Nelson, frequently seen in Waimea, Motueka and Nelson Est. Waimea Est, c.62 on 8/6. Nelson Haven, c.20 in May (PG,ZW).

## LITTLE SHAG P.melanoleucos

Nelson, frequent particularly on Motueka and Waimea Ests, and many inland sites. Best's I, Rocks Rd, and Haulashore I, roosting with Pied Shags. Occur in low numbers on West Coast. Orowaiti Est, 2 on 22/7. Tauranga Bay, 2 on 3/6. L Ryan, 2 + 2 juv on 20/7, 5 on 19/8, 2 on 12/9, 5 + 1 juv on 11/10, 3 + 1 juv on 11/1, 1 on 13/2, 8/3, 5/4, 3/5, 9 on 31/5, 3 on 28/6. Range Crk Lgn, 1 on 11/10, 5/4, 2 on 3/5, 31/5, 1 on 28/6. Grey R Est, 1 on 12/9, 13/2, 3/5, 31/5. Blaketown Lgn, 1 on 8/3, 2 on 5/4. New R Est, 1 on 9/3 (CSL). Saltwater Crk, nesting in progress at small colony on 28/10/88 (PAL), 16 ad and 9 nests in willows on 3/10 (KCH,SP). Horseshoe L, Christchurch, 14 roosting on 21/8, summer 89/90 new colony with 3 nests established. Upper Lyttelton Hbr, max 79 on 17/5 (AC). Selwyn oxbow, L Ellesmere, c.150 nests with breeding in progress on 18/9/88 (PAL). L Lyndon, max 27 on 10/6 (PAL). L Clearwater, 2 on 10/6 (PJH,JW).

#### KING SHAG Leucocarbo carunculatus

Duffer's Reef colony, reported by fisherman as deserted on 4/3. Sentinel Rock, c.10 not breeding on 4/3 (PAL).

Oamaru, 1 on 1/4/88. Goat I, Moeraki, 1500-2000 on 1/4/88, 75% dark phase (GW). Centre I, Foveaux Str, 2 colonies: 1 with 14 ad (7 bronze phase) on 13 nests with 17 chicks, 1 with 22 ad (8 bronze) on 12 nests with 7 chicks, on 26/10 (WJC).

## CHATHAM ISLAND SHAG L.onslowi

Pitt I, Chatham Is, well dispersed singly or in small groups on 22/3. Rangatira I, c.20 on 22/3-7/4 (CFJO'D).

## SPOTTED SHAG Stictocarbo punctatus

Tasman Bay, 2500-3000 again during winter, some birds remaining over summer. Golden Bay, unconfirmed nesting (GDQ). Perpendicular Pt, 532 on 22/7, 551 on 14/10. Taramakau Est, 3 on 9/2, 2 on 20/3. Blaketown Lgn, 1 on 4/6 (CSL). Waimakariri RM, frequently roosting on sandspit, max 384 on 1/12, 300 + on 31/4 (PAL). Upper Lyttelton Hbr, max 81 on 17/5 (AC). Greenpark, nr Lincoln, 1 imm found run over on road well inland on 2/12 (PAL). Birdling's Flat, c.280 in 10 min on 22/10/88 compared to c.10 over 30 min on 18/4/89 (PAL), c.4500 feeding c.1 km offshore on 16/4 (AC). Centre I, Foveaux Str, 149 ad, 116 nests, 1 chick on 26/10 (WJC).

Ashley Est, 1 on 5/7 (AC), 3/10, then absent until 1 on 16/5 which stayed through June (TC,KCH,SP,PR). L Forsyth, 1 during winter 1990, first seen 23/5 (TC). L Waihola, 2 on 29/9, still present 16/1 (PS), and still 1 present on 4/2 (PG).

Nelson, usual records of solitary birds from Golden Bay, Abel Tasman NP, Motueka Est and Nelson Hbr. Motupipi Est, 2 on 6/2. Wainui Inlet, 3 on 6/2 (AC). Maitai Channel, 2 including 1 juv on 2/9 (GDQ). Moturaru I, Queen Charlotte Sd, 1 on 24/7. Ship Cove, 1 on 27/7 (BAN). Tura Bay, Tennyson Inlet, 1 on 4/10. Titirangi Bay, 1 on 5/9. Allports I, 2 in Aug. D'Urville I, 2 on east coast and 1 at Mill Arm on 27/2. Regularly observed at Ngakuta and Whatamango Bays, Queen Charlotte Sd. Several seen at Croiselles Hbr in Oct (DB). Kaikoura Pen, 1 on 4/4 and 1-2 records each month since (BEE). Very rare in Canterbury, no reports this year but some known to survive on Bank's Pen and Nth Canterbury coast (AC). Boulder B, Otago Pen, 2 on 12/10 (JTD). Bruce Rock, Brighton, Dunedin, 1 on 3/6 (MAM). Martin's Bay, 1 on 24/5 (DE). King's Rock, east of Tautuku Bay, 1 on 7/1 (RAD).

#### CATTLE EGRET Bubulcus ibis
