CLASSIFIED SUMMARISED NOTES, NORTH ISLAND 1 JULY 1990 TO 30 JUNE 1991

Compiled by G. A. TAYLOR and G. R. PARRISH

Classified Summarised Notes (CSN) were provided by 228 members and friends of the Ornithological Society of New Zealand (OSNZ). This year observations were received from all regions and in addition 7 members provided individual notes. Large and detailed summaries were received from Hawkes Bay, Bay of Plenty and Northland regions. CSN provides a forum for OSNZ members to publish regular or incidental bird observations from a variety of habitats including lakes, rivers, wetlands, estuaries, beaches, coastal waters, forests, farmland and residential areas. Brief anecdotal observations on bird behaviour are also included in CSN. All records from kiwi to herons plus skuas, gulls and terns were collated by GAT, and waterfowl to waders and pigeons to passerines were collated by GRP.

NORTH ISLAND BROWN KIWI Apteryx australis mantelli

[FN] Puketi SF, 1 male followed by 1 female heard at c0200h on Bramleys Ridge on 2/11. One male heard at 2200h at HQ on 5/11 (GRP). [N] Waipoua SF, 7 birds monitored from June to Jan. Of these, 2 were killed by cars. One unmonitored bird was also found road-killed (RJP). [A] Tapora Bush Res, 2 or 3 heard on 16/11 (MJT). [VP] Opuiaki Ecological Area, Kaimai-Mamaku CP, 1 on 4/4; Rotoehu SF, 1 heard on 10/11 (GR V15 239523) (per KLO). [T] Okoki Valley, Uruti, heard calling on 29/11 (WBM). [HB] Makino Hut, Kaweka SFP, birds heard on 2 consecutive nights in Nov '90 (log entry by David Appleton per R&TAS), heard at night on 31/12 (R&TAS). Boundary Stm, between Pohukura and Heay's Access Rds, northwest of L Tutira, reliable report of at least 1 prior to 23/6 (per JWC, DOC). Central Ruahine SFP: 1 reliably reported just north of L Colenso; Upper Makaroro R, 1 reported (per JA).

LITTLE SPOTTED KIWI A. owenii

[SA] Red Mercury I, very little calling activity from 10-17/10, only 5 calls heard during extensive night-time surveys around the island. More activity from 28/3 to 1/4, 5 seen (at least 2 unbanded) and 6+ calls heard (GAT, AJT).

NEW ZEALAND DABCHICK Poliocephalus rufopectus

[FN] Ngataki dune lakes: Wingy L, 6 on 5/1; Half L, 3 on 5/1 including 1 imm; Black L, 2 on 5/1 (RJP). L Ngakapua, 3 on 28/11 (ACR). Kaitaia: L Rotoroa, 1 on 10/4; L Heather, 7 on 10/4 together with 6 Australasian Little Grebe. Birds in prs or trios. Occasionally the two species were mixed and when this occurred, birds appeared to be compatible (PA). [N] L Humuhumu, Pouto, 3 on 15/9 (GRP). Lake 3 km west of North Kaipara Head, 8 on 23/2 (GRP, PC). [A] South Kaipara Ls, 30 on 17/2, 69 on 16/6 (SM, OSNZ group). L Kereta, 29 on 12/5 (GAP). Mangere SP, 3 on 30/4 (SJD). [BP] Matata, 2 on 1/7, 3/11 and 18/5; Awaiti Wetlands, 2 on 1/7 and 30/12 (PCL, AM, RMW). Sullivan's L, Whakatane, 1 pr + 1 chick on 18/9; Awatapu Lag, Whakatane, 1 on 23/1; L Taramaranui, 1 pr with 1 chick riding on back of adult on 30/12 (RMW). L Aniwhenua, 3 prs on

23/9, 10 birds on 3/2 (PCL, WMH). [VP] L Okareka, on 25/10, bird moved out of water onto log, another followed, copulation accompanied by purring noise for 15 seconds (RG, JGI). L Taupo: Motuoapa, 5 plus 3 more in marina on 10/3; Tokaanu outflow, 20 + on 10/3 (AJT, PFB). [G/W] Whakaki Lag, 1 on 12/5; Wairoa R, 3 together by town bridge on 20/7 (GAF). [Wg] L Rotoaira, 2 on 10/3 (AJT, PFB). [M] Manawatu wetland survey: total of 363 on 30-31/3, similar count to 1984, but marked changes in some individual lakes (HAR et al.). Pukepuke Lag, 21 on 5/5 (RC). Foxton No.1 L, max 10 on 22/7; Foxton No.2 L, max 2 on 25/8; Heatherlea Pond, Levin, 1 on 17/12, 3/2 and 31/3 (JLM, BDH). Rakauhamana Lag, south of Hokio, 5 on 16/3; Ngakawau Lag, near Levin, 9 on 25/3 (MO). [HB] L Tutira, 4 on 17/2 (GAF), usually c6 (MTC). North Pond, Westshore, 7 on 6/2, larger number than usual and unusual time of year to be present, perhaps because of drying out of other habitats. One bird diving in very shallow water had back and tail projecting above water. Still 7 present throughout May-June. Birds not usually in this slightly saline pond though often nearby (ARG, R&TAS, M&PWT). Fernhill: Hurimoana Swamp, 26 on 22/7 (OSNZ) group); L Kautuku, 10 on 15/7; L Runanga, 6 in very small part of lake; L Oingo, 13 on 5/5, the only report in recent years (CFM, JGH). Still widespread in Hawkes Bay and numerous in Fernhill district (MTC). [W] Waikanae E, 1 on 29/6 (AJT). Paraparaumu, pond opposite airport, 4 on 3/1 (D&MS), 1 pr + 2 chicks on 23/2 (AJT, BAT).

AUSTRALASIAN LITTLE GREBE Tachybaptus novaehollandiae

Appears to be well established in Northland with birds present at a number of lakes and farm ponds (GAT). [FN] Ngataki: Half L, 1 imm on 5/1 (RJP), 1 on 6/1 (not the imm) (VH); Black L, 2 in March (RJP). Waipapakauri: L Rotokawau, 11 on 11/4 (GRP, PM); L Rotowhero, 5 on 18/2 (HS). Kaitaia: L Rotoroa, 2 on 10/4; L Heather, 6 on 10/4 (PA). Kerikeri Ponds, 2 in Aug (RJP). [N] L Owhareiti, Pakaraka, 2 on 8/1 and 18/2 (GRP, HS). Kaikohe, Mataraua Rd, 2 adults on farm pond in July; Withering Heights, Waipu Cove, 1 on farm pond on 22/1 (RJP). [A] L Kereta, 2 on 17/2 (BJE), 4 on 3/6 (DJ&PJA).

ROYAL ALBATROSS Diomedea epomophora

[M] Foxton B, 3 passing north on 15/9, showing completely dark upperwing of northern race birds (JLM).

BLACK-BROWED MOLLYMAWK D. melanophrys

[BP] Mayor I, 1 or 2 imms seen regularly offshore between 22/10 and 31/12, 1 adult on 23/1; Mt Maunganui to Mayor I, 2 imms + 1 adult on 22/7 and 22/8, 1 imm on 25/8 and 31/8, 2 imms from 21/9 to 13/10, max 5 imms on 14/10, 4 imms on 23/10, 1 adult on 9/5, another, possibly race melanophrys on 27/6; 3 km North of Motiti I, 1 adult on 3/10 and 25/10; Mt Maunganui to Motiti I, 2 adults, 1 of race impavida on 2/5, 1 adult impavida on 23/6 (JEH).

WHITE-CAPPED MOLLYMAWK D. cauta

[BP] Motiti I, 1 offshore on 23/6 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, 2 on 22/7, 100 + passing north on 15/9, 1 on 30/12 (birds not identified to race) (JLM).

SALVIN'S MOLLYMAWK D. cauta salvini

[BP] Mayor I, 7km SW, 1 on 25/9, another on the eastern side on 4/11 (JEH).

YELLOW-NOSED MOLLYMAWK D. chlororhynchos

[BP] Mayor I, 1 adult and 1 imm offshore on 20/6; Mt Maunganui to Mayor I, 2 adults and 1 imm on 22/7, 9 of mixed ages on 28/7, 2 imms and 1 adult on 25/8, 1 imm on 26/8, 1 adult on 30/8 and 6/9, 1 imm and 2 adults on 27/6; Near Motiti I, 1 adult on 20/7 and 4/8, 1 imm on 30/4, 1 adult on 23/6; Astrolabe Reef, 1 adult on 12/7; Pudney Reef, 1 imm on 31/7, 1 adult and 1 imm on 19/8, 1 imm on 31/5; Karewa I, 3 adults and 2 imms 4 km NE on 10/7 (JEH).

BULLER'S MOLLYMAWK D. bulleri

[BP] Mayor I, 2 offshore on 23/12; Motiti I, 1 offshore on 23/6 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, 1 passing north close to shore on 15/9 (JLM).

LIGHT-MANTLED SOOTY ALBATROSS Phoebetria palpebrata

[Wk] Waingaro, near Raglan, 1 found alive on farm on 3/6, died later (HT). [BP] Arataki, Mt Maunganui, 1 found dead on beach on 20/8 (CL).

ALBATROSS/MOLLYMAWK Diomedea sp.

[M] Ohakea pilot returning from Marlborough Sounds on 21/6 saw 100s resting on the sea 100 km out and extending as far north as Wanganui, but none within 16 km of the coast (IS).

FLESH-FOOTED SHEARWATER Puffinus carneipes

[FN] North Cape, 100s offshore on 13/10 with Buller's Shearwaters (GRP). Motuopao I, 100s offshore on 14-17/11 (RJP). [N] Hen I, 100s offshore during day on 30/12 (GA&SLT). [A] Kauwahaia I, female with swollen cloaca caught on surface on 21/11 (GAT). [SA] Middle I, Mercury group, many chicks noted from 23-28/3 (PJT). Red Mercury I, none found during visits from 10-17/10 and 28/3-1/4. A few seen offshore during day on 17/10 (GAT). [BP] Off Mayor I, 2 on 25/9, c100 around boat on 11/10 and 23/10, 1 on 12/5 then none seen on 15/5; Off Motiti I, very few on 21/4, 2 on 30/4, 1 or 2 on 2-5/5, thereafter none seen (JEH). Whakatane to White I, 20-25 on 24/3 on the return trip, all birds heading east (PCL).

BULLER'S SHEARWATER P. bulleri

[FN] North Cape, 100s flying north on 13/10. Flesh-footed Shearwaters also present but outnumbered 2:1 by Buller's (GRP). Cape Reinga, 100 + on 28/11, seen over 20 minutes flying SW (ACR). Cape Maria Van Diemen, Tapotupotu Bay and Kapowairua, seen offshore on 20-22/2 (HS). [N] Poor Knights group: c100 on trip out and 1 found in burrow on Archway I on 22/9; Aorangi I, none seen ashore on 20/11 (GRP); Chicks noted as common on Tawhiti Rahi I and very abundant on Motu Kapiti I in mid-March (PM). Hen I, 100s offshore during day on 30/12, thousands flying north on 4/1 (100 counted in 15 minutes, with a ratio of 100 Buller's to 10 Flesh-footed to 1 Fluttering Shearwater) (GA&SLT). [SA] FoT, several on 24/1 (RJ&BGL). Otautu Bay, Coromandel, 2 feeding in bay on 17/2 (BHS). Red Mercury I, 1 offshore on 17/10 (GAT), common offshore in late afternoon on 1/4 (AJT, GAT). [BP] Off Mayor I, 1 on 15/9, a few on 25/9, 3 fed around

boat on 4/11 (an unusual behaviour for this species). This feeding behaviour was noted again on 10-11/11 and 24/2. On 12/5, very few left then none seen on 15/5; Astrolabe Reef, 3 on 3/11 feeding around boat; Off Motiti I, a few seen on 30/4, 2-5/5 and 9/5 then no further sightings (JEH). Whakatane to White I, 30-40 on 24/3 on the return trip, all birds heading east (PCL).

SOOTY SHEARWATER P. griseus

[FN] Motuopao I, a few ashore at night on 14-17/11 (RJP). [A] Kauwahaia I, female with palpable egg on 21/11 (GAT). [SA] Red Mercury I, 1 pr found in burrow on 14/10, 2 others heard calling in flight from 10-17/10. Hundreds seen offshore heading south on 17/10. Pair present by burrow behind Rolypoly Bay, feeding a chick on 31/3 (GAT). [BP] Near Mayor I, 1 on 21/9, 25-26/9 and 2/10, 2 rafts of c70 birds sitting on the water on 11/10 and considerable numbers flying by heading east. By 13/10, numbers had dropped to a "few" and only 1 seen on 14/10 and 8 on 22/10. On 23/10, 20-30 extremely hungry birds were around the boat and 3 dead birds were seen floating in sea. On 27/10, numerous "sooties" flying past and all fishing boats in the area were attended by flocks of very hungry birds. 6 on 4/11, 2 on 10/11, 3 on 11/11 and only 1 seen on each of 7 visits to Mayor I waters between 16/11 and 16/1. Last birds seen, 2 on 5/5 and 1 on 12/5; near Motiti I, 2 on 9/10, 6-8 on 25/10, 4 on 28/10, 3 on 8/11, 2 on 15/11, 1 on 6/12 and 19/12, 2 on 23/6, 1 on 27/6 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, 100 + passing north on 6/10, c10 on 25/12 (JLM).

SHORT-TAILED SHEARWATER P. tenuirostris

[A] Little Barrier I, 1 found on beach in mid-Aug '89, was possibly washed ashore in July (TCG, MD). [BP] Near Mayor I, 1 on 4/1; near Motiti I, 1 on 19/12 and 17/1 (JEH).

FLUTTERING SHEARWATER P. gavia

[FN] Motuopao I, first breeding proven on 16/11 with 1 half grown chick (128g). Thousands offshore during day (RIP). Spirits Bay, c4000 on 2/5 feeding in large rafts 50 - 500 m offshore from Panehe I (GAT). Wekarua I, 100 + prs breeding on 9-10/2 (GRP, PM). [N] Helena Bay, 200-300 feeding close to shore on 4/2 (GRP), [SA] Double I, Mercury group, 2 ashore on 30/3 (IM). Red Mercury I, small numbers heard calling in flight around coastal margin at night from 10-17/10 but only 2 seen ashore (in Rolypoly Bay). Hundreds flying south offshore on 17/10 (GAT). [BP] Karewa I, a large flock of 300-400 feeding near island on 24/11 (PCL). [T] Rapanui, 1 skull under flax on 28/7 (AJT). Carr's Rd, Urenui, on mainland opposite offshore stack, 1 predator-killed bird, dead c1 month on 28/7 (AJT, GAT), at least 5 seen on offshore stack on 25/8, some clearly associated with burrows. One desiccated corpse found in burrow entrance on nearby mainland on 18/5 (DGM). [M] Foxton B, max of 5000 per hour passing north on 30/3, c50 offshore on 25-26/12 (JLM). [W] Breaker Bay, Wellington, 350+ offshore on 17/3, first of the large winter flocks to congregate in this area (GAT).

LITTLE SHEARWATER P. assimilis

[SA] Middle I, Mercury group, 3 noted on 23-28/3 (PJT). Red Mercury I, common from 10-17/10. Frequently seen on surface at night all over the island. One bird found incubating a well-developed egg on 14/10 (GAT); none seen or heard from 28/3 to 1/4 (GAT, AJT). [BP] Mayor I, 3 or 4 offshore on 12/5 (JEH).

SHEARWATER Puffinus sp.

[HB] Pania Reef, Napier, large flock of Hutton's or Fluttering Shearwaters close inshore on 30/9 (KVT).

COMMON DIVING PETREL Pelecanoides urinatrix

[FN] Motuopao I, common, nesting on ridges. Well grown chicks and a few adults ashore during day and many adults at night on 14-17/11 (RJP). [N] Poor Knights group: c50 seen on trip out on 22/9; Aorangi I, several seen ashore on 20/11 (GRP); a few noted on Tawhiti Rahi I and Motu Kapiti I in mid-March (PM). [SA] Middle I, Mercury group, c.40 ashore each night on 23-28/3 (PJT). Red Mercury I, present in low numbers around the coastal fringe from 10-17/10 (GAT). [Wk] Kiwitahi, near Morrinsville, 1 found alive on 19/11, died later (ASR). [BP] Mayor I, a few offshore on 24/3, the first noted for some time. On 29/3, very large numbers were in the area and were regularly seen during first week of April (JEH). Karewa I, c30 widely spread over the sea 3-5 kms north of island on 24/11 (PCL). [T] New Plymouth, 2 on city streets on 11/12; 1 flew onboard Maui Rig on 24/7, later released (DGM).

BLACK PETREL P. parkinsoni

[BP] Off Mayor I, 1 from 16/1 to 6/2, 3 on 18/2, feeding around the boat in heavy rain, 1 on 24/2, 3/3, 28/3 and 1/4; Motiti I, 1 offshore on 8/4 and 30/4 (JEH).

WESTLAND PETREL P. westlandica

[G/W] Tolaga Bay, 1 on 27/1, 42 km offshore (GAF).

WHITE-CHINNED PETREL P. aequinoctialis

[Wr] Cape Palliser, 1 on 4/1, 2 km offshore (DMS).

BLACK PETREL Procellaria sp.

[M] Foxton B, singles passing south on 25-26/8, 2 passing north on 15/9 (JLM).

KERGUELEN PETREL Lugensa brevirostris

[T] New Plymouth to Waitara, 6 found alive between 14-28/8, some died and some released (DGM). [HB] Cape Kidnappers, 1 dead on beach on 25/7, an unusual find (KVT).

CAPE PIGEON Daption capense

[N] The Pinnacles, Poor Knights, 1 looking for food around small boat on 22/9 (GRP). [BP] Near Mayor I, 4 on 22/7, 5 on 22/8, 1 followed boat in as far as "A" beacon at Tauranga H entrance on 26/8, 1 on 31/8, 14/10, 22/10 and 27/6; Penguin Shoals, 2 on 13/9; Near Motiti I, 2 on 3/7, 1 on 20/7, 6 on 23/6 (JEH). Mt Maunganui, 1 died on 5/8 after crashing into a TV aerial during NE gale (CL). [W] Wellington H, off Seatoun wharf, 100's seen on 27/8 with arrival of cold front (BDB).

ANTARCTIC PETREL Thalassoica antarctica

[Wg] Rangatiki E, 1 exhausted on 7/10, later died (AJT, BAT).

ANTARCTIC FULMAR Fulmarus glacialoides

[HB] Haumoana, 1 dead on 25/8, an unusual find (KVT).

SOUTHERN GIANT PETREL Macronectes giganteus

[BP] Off Mayor I, a dark bird with greenish bill tip, yellow c/b on left leg, metal on right reported on 29/9 (PCL). Astrolabe Reef, 1 with greenish bill tip on 25/10 (JEH).

NORTHERN GIANT PETREL M. halli

[BP] Near Mayor I, none seen on 22/7, a few on 28/7, 1 on 22/8, a few on 27/10, 1 on 4/11, quite a few on 11/11, one of which was very interested in the boat, several on 27/11, numerous on 21/6 and 29/6; near Motiti I, a few on 3/7, several at Astrolabe Reef on 12/7, 3/11 and a few on 23/6; Karewa I, numerous on 10/7 busy feeding 3km north-east of island (JEH), only 1 seen in this area on 24/11 (PCL). [T] New Plymouth, 1 alive on 14/9, another on 24/9, both later released (DGM). [Wr] Lansdowne Golf Course, Masterton, a storm wrecked but healthy bird found in Jan '91, successfully released at Onoke Spit (TCH).

ANTARCTIC PRION P. desolata

[BP] Papamoa, 1 found alive in dunes during NE storm on 5/8, died later (PCL).

BROAD-BILLED PRION P. vittata

[BP] Ohope B, 1 freshly dead on 24/7 (WMH).

PRION Pachyptila sp.

[M] Foxton B, 1 offshore on 22/7 harassed by Southern Black-backed Gull (JLM).

PYCROFT'S PETREL Pterodroma pycrofti

[N] Aorangi I, Poor Knights, a few birds seen ashore on 20/11 (GRP). Hen I, 10 caught in burrows and banded from 28/12 to 4/1. Each bird was incubating an egg. Most birds responded to war-whoops during the day. Occasional flight calls were heard at night but no birds were found on surface

(GA&SLT). [SA] Red Mercury I: 3 in burrows on 10/10, responded to war-whoops but no aerial calling heard. By 15/10 at night, birds were common on surface, in burrows and much aerial calling heard. A pair were observed copulating at the burrow entrance on 16/10. From 10-17/10, 124 were banded and 250 burrows were located (Red Mercury has the largest population of this rare species); 70 fledglings banded from 28/3 to 1/4. Flight calls heard briefly on 29/3 and 1/4, otherwise silent (GAT, AJT).

GREY-FACED PETREL P. macroptera gouldi

[FN] Motuopao I, adults seen ashore at night on 14-17/11, several burrows had chicks (RJP). Cape Maria van Diemen, tens of birds chasing in prs or groups, sitting on ground or calling actively on 30/4 and 2/5 (TS, GT, GAT, GRP, DM). [N] Hen I, up to 10 adults seen flying over island on 1/1 and 1 was caught near campsite at Dragonmouth Cove on 2/1 (recognised by mixture of old and new feathers and very pale around face). Chicks, some partly downy, still present in burrows on 2/1 though most sites empty by this date. Burrows of this species were common on the ridge around the Pinnacles, even on the summit of the highest Pinnacle at 417 m asl (GA&SLT). [A] Motuora I, nesting during July/Aug (SPC). Mt Maunganui, several birds on surface during evening visit on 11/8; Mt Maunganui wharf, 1 alive on 24/12, later released (PCL). Rurima Rocks, 1 banded bird found dead in water (WMH). [T] Colonies at Sutton and Beach Rds, Omata; Carr's Rd, Urenui; and Rapanui all appear stable with little evidence of predation. About 100 birds banded during 1990 and 1991 (DGM et al.).

Waiheke I, feeding flock of c150, north of island on 22/9 (MJT, OSNZ group). [BP] Near Mayor I, 1 on 22/8, several on 25-26/8, c30 on 15/9 and c60 on 21/9; Astrolabe Reef, numerous on 22/9 (JEH). Karewa I, 8 km NE, 2025 seen over period of 30-40 minutes on 24/11 (PCL).

STORM PETREL sp.

Waitangi E/East Clive, large numbers on 7/7 in early morning hawking over coastal channels, c50 in one concentrated flock (M&PWT), 22 on 4/11, 120 + on 30/6; Tukituki E, 20 on 30/6; Porangahau E, 6 on 29/6 (OSNZ cen).

NEW ZEALAND PIPIT Anthus novaeseelandiae

[FN] Motuopao I, nest on 1/11 (RJP). [N] Whangamumu, 2 on grassy field on 26/1; Portland Cement Works, 3 on 12/5 (AJB). Hen I, 2 on shoreline rocks at eastern end on 3/1 (GAT). [A] Bethell's B, 9 on 15/9 (GJM). [Wk] Waikorea, 3 on 18/5 (ASR). Ruapuke, 3 prs on 14/4 (WIR, FN). [BP] Otamarakau, 1 at river mouth on 18/5 (PCL). Thornton Lag, 1 on 22/6; Whangaparaoa E, 1 on 14/5 (WMH). [G/W] Pouawa Stm, Gisborne, 4 on sandspit on 4/4 (GAF). [T] Omata, 1 on coastal dunes on 13/4 (REL). New Plymouth, Upper Plymouth Rd, 2 on 19/7 (RWB). [M] Moutoa, 1 on 26/12 and 15/6 (JLM). Levin, southern end Arapaepae Range, 2 on logging track on 14/3 (MO). Otaki Forks, on road in flocks of 5-10 on 23/2 (KO). [HB] Ahuriri E, 1 on road on 21/4 (CFM, JGH), not often reported here (MTC). Te Awanga, 1 on 2/12 feeding beside Maraetotara Stm, bird would run several metres with wing flapping then stop and peck (BMT). Cape Kidnappers, 4 on 14/5 (KVT). [W] Mt Climie, 9 on 6/4 (AM, JW). Te Rewarewa Pt, 2 on 15/7 (AJT).

HEDGE SPARROW Prunella modularis

[N] Onerahi, 1 singing on 18/7 (PA). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd bush edge, 3 on 2/9 (BHS). [BP] Te Puke, No.3 Rd, at least 3 males singing in c100 m of kiwifruit orchard shelterbelt on 2/7, males "tinkling" but not yet in full song on 16/6; Kaituna Cut, 1 male in full song on 28/7 (PCL). [HB] Napier, first song heard on 7/7, 1 singing at 2140h and 0140h on 26-27/11 (M&PWT). Hastings, 1 singing on 10/7 (MTC).

BLACKBIRD Turdus merula

[N] Onerahi, 1 bird in full song on 1/6, full song on 16/7 (PA). [A] Orakei, first song on 2/6 (MJT). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 2 on 2/9 (BHS). [T] New Plymouth Airport, 1 pure white bird present from at least April '91 onwards (IDH). [HB] Hastings, a partial albino female with white primaries and wing coverts seen on 18/8, male eating Indian hawthorn (Raphiolepis) berries on 10/5 (KVT), bird in full song in March '91 in city garden – very early in year (MTC). [W] Karori, 1 swallowing 15 mm diameter exotic Fuchsia fruit on 3/2 (AJT).

SONG THRUSH T. philomelos

[N] Otangarei, first song on 3/5 (TT). Onerahi, precalling on 27/4, first full song on 10/5 (PA). [A] Orakei, first song on 25/4 (MJT). [Wk] Hamilton, singing on 5/5, in full song on 14/5 (SC). [BP] Papamoa, singing rather half-heartedly on 17/4, full song on 6/5 and hence daily; Te Puke, No.3 Rd,

an all grass nest, no mud and/or wood pulp lining, containing a clutch of 3 eggs found in kiwifruit vine on 18/12 (PCL). [HB] Hastings, full song in city garden on 22/3 and in another garden in March also. Considerably earlier in year than usual (KVT, MTC).

NORTH ISLAND FERNBIRD Bowdleria punctata vealeae

[FN] Pickmere Channel, Kerikeri Inlet, 2 heard in saltmarsh and manuka on 2/4/90 (GRP). L Owhareiti, 2 in reeds on 27/9 (PA). [N] Waikare Inlet: Owae Stm and Karetu R, 8 + heard in saltmarsh on 2/3/90; Waihaha Stm. 3 heard on 2/3/90; Clendon Cove, 2 heard on 20/2 (GRP). Parekura Bay: Wairoa Stm, 2 seen, 3 more heard on 20/2; Puhinui Stm, 2 heard on 20/2 (GRP), 1 in same spot May-July (AJB). Whangamumu, 3 on 26/1, 100m north of track entrance (AJB). Avacado Rd, Maungatapere, 2 in June '90 (DH). Takahiwai, 5 heard in brackish saltmarsh and manuka on 4/3/90; Ruakaka E, 1 on southern side on 30/1, the first time seen here (none seen in over 20 previous visits); Whakaki R, Kaipara, 2 heard dueting on 22/2 (GRP). [SA] Whitianga, 1 heard on 28/7, 1 seen on 8/9 and 22/9, 1 seen and 1 further heard on 9/3 (MBM). Meremere, 3 prs seen on 26/8 (DJ&PJA, PH). Kairito, Waitakaruru, heard on 1/6 (PJA, RJP). [Wk] Torehape Peat Dome, common on 13/10 (BHS). [BP] Waikareao E, Tauranga H, 1 on 1/1 (KLB). Ohope Spit, 1 on 22/9; Ohiwa H, 3 at Wainui Rd SP on 7/11 (WMH). Waioeka E, up to 10 seen in reedbed on Huntress Crk on 5/11 and birds were sighted on a number of visits made between then and 5/1 (WHS). [VP] Whakarewarewa SFP, Reservoir Rd, 1 bird calling and 2 birds seen on 20/5 (KLO). [T] Mohakatino, heard on 22/5 (ALE). Mt Dampier, 3 on 8/9 (WBM). Te Wera SF, several on 15/9 (DGM et al.). Poetama Swamp, East Egmont, 2 heard on 24/2 (KSB). [Wg] Moumahaki L, (GR. R21 533673) and unnamed L (GR. R21 549689), birds responded to Spotless Crake tapes at both sites on 30/1 (CCO). [M] Foxton No.1 L, 1 on 16/9, 18/11, 23/12 and 1/1 (JLM). [HB] Mokamoka Rd, Waikoau SF, 4 on 5/1 in small area of raupo (CFM). Puketitiri, birds reported to be in good numbers at Hot Springs Rd on 10/2 (JRB). Kaweka SFP, 7 heard in different areas on Makino Track on 25/11 and many heard near Makino Hut on 31/12, none seen on tramp on 21-28/1 (R&TAS), 1 in scrub outside MacIntosh Hut on 2/2 (BS). Ruahine Range, birds are in significant numbers in some northern parts of range at altitudes towards 1100 m from Big Hill Station up towards No Man's Hut (JWC).

WHITEHEAD Mohoua albicilla

[Wk] Pirongia: Western Track, 12 on 14/9 (PDC); Te Kihi Track, 15 on 27/2 (SC). Te Kauri Res, flock on 30/8, first record for the reserve in many years (WIR). L Waipapa, 1 singing in willow beside highway on 23/8 (RSS). Dubbo Crk, northern Kaimai Range, several on 15/5 (KLO). [VP] Mangaroa Stm, Kaimai/Mamaku CP, several on 19/3 (KLO). [T] Pukeiti Rhododendron Trust, flock of 12 on 10/2 accompanied by Fantails, Grey Warblers and Silvereyes, another similar flock on 30/6. The species has noticeably increased in this area over recent years (DGM). [HB] Bellbird Bush SR, present on 5/1 (CFM, JGH). Kaweka SFP: Makino Track, 3 on 25/11 (R&TAS); Little's Clearing/Makahu Hut, present on 26/12 (CFM). Blowhard Bush Res, birds heard on 13/10; Lawrence Hut, 6 seen on 13/10

(M&PWT). Fernbird Bush, 10-15 near road on 26/6 (JRB). Boyd's Bush SR, numerous on 14/10 (KVT). Ruahine Range, 4-6 in beech near Triplex Hut and a small group higher on Armstrong Saddle Track (OSNZ group).

GREY WARBLER Gerygone igata

[Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 7 on 2/9 (BHS). [HB] Napier/Taihape Rd, many on 14/10, I had small ball of fluff in bill, lost it, retrieved it in mid-air and flew away with it (KVT). Still plentiful throughout region and many in Kaweka SFP (TAS, CFM et al.). [W] Mt Climie, 23 counted on 6/4 (AM, JW).

NORTH ISLAND FANTAIL Rhipidura fuliginosa placabilis

[N] Tawhiti Rahi I, Poor Knights, only c10 seen on 13-21/3 (GRP, PM et al.). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 6 on 2/9 (BHS). [BP] Te Puke, No.3 Rd, abundant in kiwifruit orchards June-Aug (PCL). [T] New Plymouth, pair on 2/9 gathering nest material (DGM). [HB] Taradale, in winter '90, birds unusually numerous at Waiohiki Golf Course and on all sections of course instead of usual 2-3 favoured places. Many throughout region (MTC). [W] Mornington, 1 black Fantail on 10/3 (WL). Botanical Gardens, 1 on 19/6 with no tail but quite manoeuvrable (AM).

NORTH ISLAND TOMTIT Petroica macrocephala toitoi

[FN] Sweetwater, 1 male on 10/4 heard singing in manuka, many km from 'normal' habitat south of Kaitaia (GRP, PM). [N] Waipoua SF, 1 male in Tane Mahuta on 23/2 (HGS). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 8 on 2/9 (BHS). [HB] Kaweka SFP, reports from several parts of park, fairly munerous sightings on tramp on 21-28/1 (R&TAS, CFM). Ruahine Range, present on Armstrong Saddle Track on 27/4 (CFM, JGH).

NORTH ISLAND ROBIN P. australis longipes

[BP] Te Puke, a male heard singing in bush gully between kiwifruit orchards, well up No.3 Rd on 21/3 (PCL). [VP] Mangaroa Stm, Kaimai/Mamaku CP, common on 19/3 (KLO). Pureora SFP, 3 with 1 chick being fed (RSG). [HB] Kaweka SFP: 2 on tramp on 21-28/1, 1 seen, 2 heard on 31/3 in MacIntosh Hut area (R&TAS), 3 on 2/2 near Kuripapango Ls carpark in exotic forest (BS). Fernbird Bush, 1 by stream (JRB).

SILVEREYE Zosterops lateralis

[Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, large flocks on 3/9 (BHS). [BP] Kauri Pt, a small group of 8-10 feeding on pastureland, working their way through grass and weeds with a flock of c100 finches on 6/6 (BC). Te Puke, No.3 Rd, a number of nests found in kiwifruit vines on 5-6/2 (PCL). [HB] Kaweka SFP, still abundant on 2128/1 (R&TAS). Boyd's Bush SR, numerous on 14/10 (KVT). [W] Waikanae, 1 feeding from *Grevillea* flowers on 22/7 (AJT). Vogeltown, 25 in a flock feeding (AKB).

BELLBIRD Anthornis melanura

[FN] Waima SF, I reported seen eating fruit on 12/8 (GRP). [A] Waiheke I, 60 birds released into three areas (ML). [SA] Red Mercury I, 1 eating mapou fruit on 31/3 (AJT, GAT). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 6 on 2/9 (BHS). Northern Kaimai Range, present around Dubbo Crk on 15/5 (KLO). [BP] Te Puke, No.3 Rd, a dawn chorus of song

heard coming from eucalypt shelterbelts in kiwifruit orchards on 21/7 (PCL). Whale I, numerous on 11/11 (WMH). Kawerau, seen about the town throughout the year, now common (RMW). [VP] Mangaroa Stm, Kaimai/Mamaku CP, present on 19/3 (KLO). [T] Pukeiti Rhododendron Trust, several feeding on Fuchsia nectar on 10/1 (DGM). [HB] Holt's Res, Waikoau, 2 on 2/9 taking nectar from Grevillea flowers; L Opouahi, numerous in forest on 29/5 (KVT). Kaweka and Ruahine SFP, still present (R&TAS). Napier/Taihape Rd: Blowhard Bush SR, several seen and heard on 13/10 (M&PWT); Fernbird Bush, many present on 26/6, 4 heard calling at once (JRB); Boyd's Bush SR, numerous on 14/10 (KVT). Havelock North, 2 in village garden (first sighting in garden) on 1/4 (FET). Kopua, occasional sightings of single birds on farmland in last 4-5 years but not in that area for many years previously (MTC).

TUI Prosthemadera novaeseelandiae

[FN] Kumi Rd, Awanui, 14 prs in Aug-Sept in flame trees (MCH). [N] Rawhiti, pr with 2 young on 18/5-15/6; Russell SF, pr with three-quarter grown young on 29/3 (AJB). [A] Kauwahaia I, feeding from karo flowers on 25/8 (GAT, AJT, PS). Casnell I, several feeding from kowhai flowers (AJT). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 2 on 2/9 (BHS). [BP] Te Puke, No.3 Rd, numerous in kiwifruit orchard shelterbelts and residential gardens throughout year. One or both members of a pr watched collecting dry grasses with which to line a nest being built 9 m up in a poplar tree shelterbelt in kiwifruit orchard on 12/12 (PCL). [T] Barrett Lag, New Plymouth, pr commencing nest c4 m up in crown of mapou on 20/10 (DGM). New Plymouth, 1 feeding from Formosan cherry flowers on 28/7 (AJT). [HB] Boundary Stm SR, present on 5/1 (CFM). Holt's Res, Waikoau, 2 taking nectar from rhododendron flowers on 2/9 (KVT). Te Pohue, 2 at 'Trellinoe' Gardens eating idesia berries on 19/8 (ARG, ALH, ACS). Kaweka SFP, several summer records of small numbers of birds throughout the park (R&TAS, CFM). Lawrence Hut, present on 13/10 (no Bellbirds at this site) (M&PWT). Still present in many lowland reserves in region. Also seen in open country and some urban areas when feeding conditions are suitable (MTC). [W] Heretaunga, 1 feeding from five-finger flowers on 9/8 (AJT). Karori, Marsden School grounds, 1 on 5/4, 2 months earlier than usual (BAT). Vogeltown, 1 on 12/4 to 6/5, 3 on 20/5 and still present during June (AKB).

YELLOWHAMMER Emberiza citrinella

[BP] Te Puke, No.3 Rd, a male perched on a powerline gave two bursts of full song then flew off on 3/8 (a warm sunny day) (PCL). [HB] Napier, 80-100 feeding in Nelson Park on c1-15/9 (M&PWT). Fernhill, arrived for winter at vineyard (JGH). East Clive, several feeding on exposed waterweed near sewer outfall with Chaffinches on 21/7 (M&PWT).

CIRL BUNTING E. cirlus

[N] Whangamumu, 1 male in full breeding plumage 100 m from old whaling station on 26/1 (AJB).

CHAFFINCH Fringilla coelebs

[N] Hen I, 1 in full song below Baldy on 31/12 (GA&SLT). [A] Orakei,

first song on 28/7 (MJT). [Wk] Pirongia, Corcoran's Rd to Bald Spur, 3 on 2/9 (BHS).

GREENFINCH Carduelis chloris

[SA] Cook's B, Whitianga, flock of 15 on 27/3 feeding on seed capsules of Cakile maritima on the beach (AJT, GAT). [BP] Maketu Spit, c30 feeding on fruit of Muehlenbeckia on 19/5 (PCL). [M] Whirokino, c500 on thistles on 10/3 (JLM). [HB] Ahuriri E, flock of 800-1000 feeding on bare but recently disturbed soil patches in grass field behind estuary on 2/6 (M&PWT). [Wr] Tauherenikau Race Course, 2000 + feeding on seeding turnips in May (BWB). [W] Waikanae SP, dozens on 28/10 (AJT, GAT).

GOLDFINCH C. carduelis

[SA] Miranda, flock of 500 + on 19/4 (ACR). [M] Foxton No.1 L, c200 on 22/7 (JLM). [HB] Ahuriri E, large numbers seen during winter in waste land beside estuary (M&PWT). Napier/Hastings, still flocking on 4/9, c50 at Marine Parade and c40 at Te Awa Ave, smaller flocks seen around Hastings until at least 17/10, flocking in April to seedheads of cosmos in Napier City garden (M&PWT, MTC). Sunrise Hut, central Ruahines, c12 on 17/7 just at bushline (1220m asl) (BMT).

REDPOLL C. flammea

[FN] Puketi SF, Omataroa Ridge, 3 on road margins on 2/6 (AJB). [T] Pukeiti Rhododendron Trust, flock of 40 on 14/10 (DGM). [HB] Fernhill, numerous in an orchard on 9-10/3 while mistnetting (M&PWT).

HOUSE SPARROW Passer domesticus

[N] Hen I, 1 male seen, another bird heard calling at Knights Rock on 3/1 (GAT). [T] Oakura, 1 in Feb seen catching large cicadas, pulling wings off and carrying bodies away (GFB). [HB] Napier, 1 on 6/8 flew out of brown packet lying on Marine Parade as car approached (KVT). Twyford, 1 chocolate coloured bird on 17/7 (JW). [W] Waikanae, 1 eating 10 cm green stick insect, breaking legs off on 23/12; Hataitai, 1 eating cicada on 2/2; Wadestown, 1 eating large cicada on 4/3 (AJT).

STARLING Sturnus vulgaris

[N] North of Whangarei, uncommon (AJB). Hen I, 1 at eastern point and 1 on Knights Rock on 3/1 (GAT). [M] Whirokino, 1000 + on power lines on 10/3 (JLM).

COMMON MYNA Acridotheres tristis

[N] Hen I, 4 adults seen and 1 nest located on rock stack in Lighthouse Bay on 30/12. Nearby, a dead Myna was found in a thicket of *Muehlenbeckia* with a vine snared around the wing (GA&SLT). [BP] Kawerau, seems to have declined in numbers in the district (RMW). [W] Tawa, 1 first recorded Nov '88, still present on 11/10 and June '91 (DS, AJT). Stokes Valley, 2 on 7/9, new to this area (per WL).

NORTH ISLAND KOKAKO Callaeas cinerea wilsoni

[N] Waoku Coach Rd, Matarau SF, 6 prs + several singles in winter-spring '90 (RJP). [Wk] Hauturu Rd North, 2 on 30/8 and 1/9, up to 5, Sept-March, more than have been seen there for some years (WIR). [VP] Pureora SFP, 1 heard near tower lookout by carpark on 4/3 (BMT). [T] Moki SFP,

3 on 29/3 (CL). [Wg] Kaiwhakauka Stm, (GR. R19 225904), possibly present on 30/12 (MP).

NORTH ISLAND SADDLEBACK Philesturnus carunculatus rufusater [SA] Red Mercury I, 1 eating mapou and mahoe fruit on 1/4 (AJT).

AUSTRALIAN MAGPIE Gymnorhina tibicen

[FN] Tapotupotu Bay, 1 seen on 1/5 (GAT). Te Werahi Gate, heard but not seen on 21/2 (HGS). [Wk] Dubbo Crk, northern Kaimai Range, present on 15/5 (KLO). [VP] Mangaroa Stm, Kaimai-Mamaku CP, present on 19/3 (KLO). [M] Whirokino, 110 on floodway on 17/11 (JLM).

ROOK Corvus frugilegus

[FN] Paua. 1 seen by DOC staff in spring '90 (RJP). [A] Occasional sightings of single bird in West Auckland (MJT, OSNZ Group). [SA] Mangatangi Rd, 20 in top of pine trees on 23/3 (DAL, KH), still 20 present on 28/4 and display chasing; Miranda, Findlay Rd, 100 on 28/4 (DAL). [G/W] Wairoa, 48 flying back to roost at dusk on 6/5. Numbers building up again following poisoning 3 years ago; Raupunga, c60 birds on paddock on 20/1 (GAF). [T] Inglewood, 3 reported on 20/5 are first for that area (REL). [HB] Fernhill, c250 at Swamp Rd on 22/6 (JGH, CFM). Hurimoana Swamp, 4 planing high in air currents and cawing on 22/7 (KVT). Oringi, 200 on 13/3 (KVT). Greatly reduced in numbers a few years ago by poisoning programmes but now reappearing in sizable flocks (MTC). [Wr] Tinui, 95 on 23/3 (AM, JW). [W] Wellington, Kapiti, Masterton, c2000 in 22 different breeding areas (Wellington Regional Council: 1990 Annual Report).
