# CLASSIFIED SUMMARISED NOTES, NORTH ISLAND, 1 JULY 1991 TO 30 JUNE 1992

Compiled by GRAEME A. TAYLOR and G. RICHARD PARRISH

Classified Summarised Notes (CSN) are a selection of observations provided by 248 members and friends of the Ornithological Society of New Zealand (OSNZ). This year observations were received from all North Island regions and ten members provided individual contributions. A review of the observations submitted suggests that waders and seabirds were the birds studied most frequently by OSNZ members in the past year. The purpose of CSN is to record the results of bird census counts, anecdotal observations of behaviour and to improve our understanding of NZ bird distribution. In general, those observations that do not add to our knowledge of bird distribution as shown in The Atlas of Bird Distribution in NZ are ignored. Nest record observations, band recoveries and beach patrol summaries are covered by other OSNZ schemes and usually are not included in CSN. All records from kiwi to herons plus skuas, gulls and terns were collated by GAT, and waterfowl to waders and pigeons to passerines by GRP.

### BROWN KIWI Apteryx australis

[N] Waikaraka Valley, near Whangarei, 2 heard calling on 29-30/6 (PJA). Species currently being surveyed in region by DOC (RJP). [BP] Mangakino Hut, Kaimai-Mamaku SFP, 1 on 26/2 (C.Dunseath, DOC). Otawa SR, 2 in Nov '91 (D.Brambley per KLO). [G/W] Rakaiora, East Cape, lone male called from 0.2 ha of rough roadside scrub on 8/6 (sexed from its call) (JCH). #### WHITE-CAPPED MOLLYMAWK D. cauta

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, either 1 or 2 adults on 6/7 (JEH). [HB] Cape Turnagain, 3 probables offshore on 5/10 (AJT, SB). [W] Cook Strait, 2 on 24/8 (DS), 4 on 15/10 & 19/10 (GAT, AD), 1 on 2/6 (GRP).

#### SALVIN'S MOLLYMAWK D. cauta salvini

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, 3 adults + 1 imm on 2/7, 1 adult on 6/7, 1 imm on 21/7, 1 adult on 24/7 & 28/7, 2 adults on 30/7, 1 adult + 2 imms on 31/7, 2 adults + 2 imms on 1/8, 2 adults + 1 imm on 15/8, 2 adults on 22/8, last sighting 1 adult on 6/10, 1 adult next seen on 9/6, 1 adult + 1 imm on 18/6, 2 adults on 19/6, 2 imms on 21/6 (JEH).

#### BULLER'S MOLLYMAWK D. bulleri

[FN] Cape Reinga to Three Kings I, 66 on 15/10 on trip out, c50 on 18/10 on return trip, mostly juvs. Birds also present on Rosemary Rocks (GRP). [W] Cook Strait, 2 on 15/10 (GAT, AD).

# LIGHT-MANTLED SOOTY ALBATROSS Phoebetria palpebrata

[M] Manawatu E, 1 imm blown ashore exhausted, died on 24/8 (DOC).

# FLESH-FOOTED SHEARWATER Puffinus carneipes

[FN] Cape Reinga to Three Kings I, 2 on 15/10, tens of birds seen on 18/10 (GRP). [N] Tutukaka, c50 feeding over schools of kahawai, c3km offshore on 18/2, in association with c600 Buller's Shearwaters, c1000 Fluttering Shearwaters plus c20 White-fronted Terns, 3 Arctic Skuas and c100 Red-billed Gulls. Other large flocks of seabirds were also present in this area (TCG). Coppermine I, numerous flying about western summit just before dark and calling started after darkness. From 10-15/2, 80% of burrows were occupied. One bird was noted on egg on 12/2 with tuatara also present

in same burrow. Another bird on egg on 15/2, and a small chick with its head missing was found outside a burrow – tuatara predation? (TCG). [BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, none seen between 1/7 & 26/9, a few on 27/9, 1 on 3/10, c20 feeding about boat on 6/10, numerous from 12/10 to 24/3, very few seen 26-28/3, none on 31/3, 1 or 2 seen most days in April until 26/4, after which none were seen up to 30/6 except for 2 on 2/5 (JEH). [W] Cook Strait, 6 on 15/10, following a fishing boat (GAT, AD), 4-5 on 1/3 (AJT).

### BULLER'S SHEARWATER P. bulleri

[FN] Cape Reinga to Three Kings I, hundreds seen on trip out and back on 15-18/10 (GRP). Cape Reinga, continuous flock of 50-100 per minute close to shore on 26/9 (DAL). [N] Piercy I, c200 per hour flying north over glassy water on 5/12 (GRP, PJM). Poor Knights I, c5500 on 16/9 seen on trip out and back, 1000 + on 2/11, c650 on 27/12 (GRP). [BP] Between Mayor and Motiti I, none seen between 11/7 & 12/9 (JEH), several off Mayor on 25-26/9 (RSC), 2 halfway between Mt Maunganui and Mayor I on 27/9, a few on 6-8/10, numerous on 26/10, 1 feeding about boat, slightly oiled and sickly on 1/2, seen regularly from 26/10 to 5/5, only 2 on 14/5, 16/5 & 23/5, none from 26/5 to 30/6 (JEH). [Wr] Castlepoint, c30 offshore on 22/2, most appeared to have inner primary moult and several were feeding by plunge diving after small fish at the surface (AJT, SB). [W] Cook Strait, 2 on 1/3 from ferry (AJT).

# SOOTY SHEARWATER P. griseus

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, occasional bird seen on 6/10, a few flying past and 3 eating offal by boat on 8/10, only 1 seen on 11/10 but several on 12/10 & 23-26/10, only a few on 27/10, single bird seen on each of 16 trips between 15/11 & 2/5, 2 on 16/5 & 23/5 then 1 on 26/5, 31/5, 2/6, 9/6 & last seen on 11/6 (JEH). [M] Foxton B, c30,000 passed south between 0645-0730 on 2/12, 1 on 5/4 (JL&MM). [HB] Blackhead-Porangahau, 20-30 per minute passing south on 6/10; Cape Turnagain, c80 passing south in 10 minutes on 5/10 (AJT, SB). [W] Cook Strait, c8 on 23/9 (AJT), several seen on 15/10, 2 on 19/10 (GAT, AD).

# SHORT-TAILED SHEARWATER P. tenuirostris

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, 1 fed on offal close to boat on 2/7, another on 10/7 with Fluttering Shearwaters, 1 with Flesh-footed Shearwaters on 15/11, another close to boat on 29/12 (JEH).

### FLUTTERING SHEARWATER P. gavia

[N] Coppermine I, several heard calling each night over camp on 10-15/2 (TCG). [SA] Red Mercury I, a few heard on 26/11-3/12 (SB, SA). [BP] Papamoa, flock of c100 just beyond breaker line on 24/5 (PCL). Taumaihi I, near Motiti I, nesting on 18/2 (KLO). Whale I, c20 seen offshore on 28/12 (PCL). [Wg] Wanganui R mouth, 12 on 17/4, c5km offshore (GR). [M] Foxton B, c500 passing north on 22/12, c100 on 1/1 & 3/5 (JL&MM). [Wr] Castlepoint, 1 probable offshore on 22/2 (AJT). [W] Rauoterangi Channel inside Kapiti I, passing north at 40/min at 0800 on 5/3 (HAR). Cook Strait, 10-100 on 15/10 (all had light brown plumage above and white underwings), 50-100 on 19/10, flying south and eastwards across strait (GAT, AD).

#### HUTTON'S SHEARWATER P. huttoni

[Wr] Castlepoint, c12 probably this species flying south on 22/2 (AJT). [W] Waikanae B, 2600 huttoni/gavia offshore on 8/12 (AJT). Cook Strait, small numbers on 23/9 (AJT), none seen on ferry crossing on 15/10, 1 on 19/10 (very black plumage above, darkish head and underwing) and c10 probables, mostly heading north 1-2 km off Tory Channel entrance (GAT, AD), small numbers on 1/3 (AJT).

### LITTLE SHEARWATER P. assimilis

[SA] Red Mercury I, several on 26/11-3/12 (SB, SA). [W] Nga Manu, Waikanae, 1 pale-faced fledgling recently found on local beach on 7/12 (AJT).

#### COMMON DIVING PETREL Pelecanoides urinatrix

[FN] Cape Reinga, 2 offshore on 26/9 (DAL). [A] Kauwahaia I, Te Henga, 3 caught on 6-7/7 (GAT, AJT). [BP] Mayor I, numerous on 25-26/9 (RSC). Between Mayor I and Motiti I, no records kept until 1/2, from then to 26/3 none were seen, a few seen on 27-28/3 then numerous on 31/3, none seen on either 5/4 or 7/4 but birds were seen regularly from 8/4 to 30/6 (JEH). Mt Maunganui, 1 imm landed in car saleyard on evening of 30/11, released safely on 1/12 (PCL). Motuotau I, 1 old egg in burrow on 11/8 (AJT, GAT). [W] Cook Strait, several at Tory Channel entrance on 15/10, none on 19/10 (GAT, AD).

# BLACK PETREL P. parkinsoni

[BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I: all seen near Mayor I, most near boat taking offal, 1 on 27-31/12 then 2 on 6/1, 1 on 15/1, 27-29/1, 4/2 & 20/2, 4 on 5/3 all feeding about boat halfway between Mt Maunganui and Mayor I (JEH).

# WESTLAND PETREL P. westlandica

[W] Cook Strait, 1 on 15/10 & 19/10 (GAT, AD).

#### KERGUELEN PETREL Lugensa brevirostris

[T] Waitara, 1 ashore on 6/8, later died (DGM).

### CAPE PIGEON Daption capense

[FN] Cape Reinga to Three Kings I, 8 on 15/10, 4 on 18/10 (GRP). [BP] Between Mayor I and Motiti I, 1 on 2-6/7, 2 on 7/7 & 10/7, 1 on 14-16/7, 2 on 19/7, 3 on 20/7, 2 on 21/7, 1 on 22/8, 4 on 31/8, none seen between 1/9 & 24/4, 1 on 25/4 & 28/6 (JEH). [W] Cook Strait, only a few seen on 24/8 from ferry (DS), 1 on 15/10, 2 on 19/10, 1 on 17/11 (GAT, AD, AJT, SB).

#### ANTARCTIC PETREL Thalassoica antarctica

[W] Otaihanga, 1 exhausted on 23/9 (P.Mckenzie per AJT).

# ANTARCTIC FULMAR Fulmarus glacialoides

[BP] Motiti I, 1 c4km north on 2/7 (JEH).

# SOUTHERN GIANT PETREL Macronectes giganteus

[BP] Off Motiti I, single all dark bird with greenish bill tip was hand fed from boat on 10/7, 14/7, 19-20/7 & 1/8, presumably an imm, possibly the same bird was hand fed at boat on 6/1 at Mayor I (JEH). [T] New Plymouth, 1 ashore on 13/8, released later (DGM).

# NORTHERN GIANT PETREL M. halli

[FN] Cape Reinga to Three Kings I, 4 on 15/10, 2 on 18/10 (GRP). [BP] North of Motiti I, single all dark bird with pinkish bill tip close to boat on 25/6 (JEH). [T] New Plymouth, 1 ashore on 30/12, released later (DGM). [W] Nga Manu, Waikanae, 1 with red bill tip, dark plumage to bill base, recently brought in exhausted on 7/12 (AJT). Wellington H, near Korokoro Stm, 1 being harrassed by Black-backed Gulls on 5/4 (SC). Cook Strait, 7 on 24/8, none on 1/3 from ferry (DS).

[A] Mangawhai E, 5 feeding on pingao seeds on 8/12 (GRP). Auckland Domain, 27 feeding on playing field on 1/4, flocks frequently seen in Domain this time of year; Balmoral, male & females regularly feeding on sunflower seed heads on 6/2 (EKC). [Wg] Wanganui, 100 + on 5/11 (TT). [HB] Ahuriri, 700 + on 23/5 feeding on topsoil heap (M&PWT). Porangahau, flocks of 100's mixed with Goldfinches along roadside on 6/10 (AJT, SB).

## GOLDFINCH C. carduelis

[A] Balmoral, Auckland, birds feeding regularly on cosmos flower heads on 6/2 (EKC). [G/W] Mangapapa, Gisborne, c320 on 18/9 first flocking this year (JCH).

#### REDPOLL C. flammea

[BP] Whale I, few seen on 28/12 (WHS, RMW). Takaputahi, 1 on 28/4/90 (WHS). [Wg] Turakina E, 1 on 26/1 (TT). [HB] Havelock North, large numbers of birds were a serious problem for strawberry growers in early summer (MTC). [Wr] Masterton, birds arrive in August each year, commonly seen & breed over summer months then depart around March (TCD).

#### HOUSE SPARROW Passer domesticus

[Wg] Wanganui, 1 on 3/1 with deformed foot, 1 juv still had use of leg which had broken & reset (TT). [M] Whirokino, flock of c2000 on 13/7 (JL&MM). [HB] Hastings, nesting in cup of old swallow's nest on 5/1 (BS). Te Awanga, albino seen at Keighley's Poultry Farm on 5/12 (BMT). [W] Mt Victoria, Wellington, flock feeding on pampas heads on 14/6 (AJT).

# STARLING Sturnus vulgaris

[Wg] Owhango, large flock roosting at 1715 h (dusk) on 26/4 on c100m of powerlines. They were so densely packed on the line that they initially looked like black polythene piping (GAT). [M] Whirokino, flock of c2000 on 18/4 feeding on stubble (JL&MM).

## COMMON MYNA Acridotheres tristis

[N] Whangarei, 1 reported preying on Rosella eggs (RJP). [HB] No birds were seen in Wairarapa and southern Hawkes Bay on the Pongaroa/Porangahau/Elsthorpe roads until reaching the south bank of the Tukituki R where they were common along the river margins on 30/5 (GA&SLT). # NORTH ISLAND SADDLEBACK Philesturnus carunculatus rufusater

[N] Coppermine I, common on 10-15/2 with up to 3-4 juvs still associating with most adult prs (TCG). [VP] Mokoia I, L Rotorua, 36 birds (18 males, 18 females) transferred to island from Tiritiri-Matangi I, Hauraki Gulf on 12/4 by DOC & Lakes High School (KLO).

## AUSTRALIAN MAGPIE Gymnorhina tibicen

[Wk] Sanatorium Hill, Cambridge, pr in early May dive-bombing a NZ Pigeon which had head under wing. Birds were chased off by observer who had found c12 dead pigeons severely pecked but uneaten in last 2 years. Also reports of magpies killing kingfishers in same area (PJT). [BP] Mt Tarawera, seen & heard on & near summit ridge on 1/3 (PCL).

# ROOK Corvus frugilegus

[SA] Miranda, 40 on 21/5 (AJG). Waitakaruru, 25-30 on 21/7 (BS). [VP] Rotokawau Rd, Rotorua Airport, 3 on 20/6 (CM). [G/W] Tolaga Bay, 9 on 12/10 survived extermination attempts; Ruatoria, 2 on 12/10 (JCH). [T] Waitara, 3 present about a month by 4/11 with up to 6 reported later. The first records from here (REL et al.). [Wg] Westmere L, 2 on 25/8 (OCT). [M] Aokautere, 95 in paddock on 17/5 (PFB). [HB] Te Pohue, c30 on 8/3; Puketitiri, c30 on 27/11 (KVT). Patoka, 18 on 17/9 (R&TAS). Omakere, c40 on 18/3 (KVT). Pourerere B, 9 (incl. 4 feeding on beach) on 30/5 (GA&SLT). [Wr] Tautane R mouth, 4 on 5/10; Herbertville, 2 on 6/10 (AJT, SB). Owahanga R, flock of 70 by river mouth on 29/5 (GA&SLT). Upper Plain Rd, Masterton, 30 foraging in paddock on 7/5 (MJI). [W] Porirua, 1 chased by Black-backed Gull on 25/9 (MP).
