FAIRY PRION Pachyptila turtur

[MA] Cook Strait, several hundred seen from ferry on 20/1 (BS).

COOK'S PETREL Pterodroma cooki

Victoria L, Christchurch, 16 on 16/4 (PAL). Horseshoe Lake colony, Christchurch, no nesting 1991 season, tree cut down by council. Quail I, Lyttelton Hbr, 63 on 17/4 (AC). [OT] Moeraki colony, 27 occupied nests this breeding season (TDM). Green I colony, 21 nests of which 11 empty on 27/1, max 64 on 27-28/1 (CL). # AUSTRALIAN TREE MARTIN Hylochelidon nigricans

[NE] Farewell Spit, lighthouse compound, 1 during Dec and Jan 1990-92 (OSNZ).

## NEW ZEALAND PIPIT Anthus novaeseelandiae

[WC] Widespread but uncommon, records from Millerton, Truman Track, Punakaiki B, L Ryan, Greymouth, Inchbonnie, Mt Spencer, Regina Crk, Paringa R (CSL, MD, JJ).

## HEDGE SPARROW Prunella modularis [WC] Waitaha R, common in April (MD, JJ).

[WC] Lyall, present on 9/11. Larry's Crk Walkway, 7 on 15/4, Murray's Crk, present on 9/11. Alexander R Rd, 2 on 1/4. Globe Hill, 2 on 6/8, 22/3. Moonlight Track, 1 on 15/1. Goldsborough, 1 on 28/4. Callaghans, 1 on 11/4 (CSL,PG,RS). [CA] Annandale Homestead, 12 km north of Waiau, 1 on 18/11/91 (JC). [OT] Otago Pen, 1 seen on 6/10 (AW).

#### SILVEREYE Zosterops lateralis

## BELLBIRD Anthornis melanura

Only one Central Otago atlas record (RA).

# YELLOWHAMMER Emberiza citrinella •

[WC] L Ryan, 1 on 12/9 (CSL).

## CIRL BUNTING E. cirlus

[NE] Regularly seen during winter in Motueka, Waimea Plains, Ngawhatu V, Nelson Haven saltmarshes and adjacent farmland in numbers less than 13 (GDQ). [OT] Lindis Bridge, Central Otago, 1 dead on road on 24/9 (AA). Hawea Flat, 1 in Nov (JARM).

## CHAFFINCH Fringilla coelebs

[NE] Nelson Haven saltmarshes, usual winter flocks (GDQ). [WC] Common in flocks of up to 30 (CSL,MD,JJ).

## **GREENFINCH** Carduelis chloris

[WC] Present at Millerton, Greymouth, Taipo R, usually single birds (CSL).

## GOLDFINCH C. carduelis

[WC] Millerton, 9 on 2/5. Greymouth, 1 on 21/5. Bell Hill, flocks of 15-30 on 26/4 (CSL). Waitaha R, few on 15/4. Karangarua R, common on 27/3 (MD,JJ).

## **REDPOLL** C. flammea

[WC] Flocks of up to 10-15 at Millerton, Okari Lgn, Taipo R (CSL), Smythe R, Cook R, Paringa R (MD,JJ).

# HOUSE SPARROW Passer domesticus

[WC] Common in settled areas (CSL).

# STARLING Sturnus vulgaris

[WC] Common in settled areas with flocks of up to 80 (CSL).

## AUSTRALIAN MAGPIE Gymnorhina tibicen

[NE] Absent from Golden Bay. Usual widespread records from Tapawera, Murchison and Richmond foothills in numbers less than 6 (GDQ). [WC] Becoming widespread in rural areas, Greymouth, 1 on 15/7. Blair's Farm, 2 on 26/4. Bell Hill, 4 on 26/4. Te Kinga, 1 on 26/4, a pr on 25/10. Arahura, 2 on 18/2. Mikonui, 2 on 28/9, 1 on 22/10 (CSL,PG,RS).

## **ROOK** Corvus frugilegus

[CA] Port Levy, 27 on 26/3, 185 on 13/5 after heavy snow fall (AC). Ellesmere District, seen regularly throughout year, colony in macrocarpas at English Rd cut down, birds moved to eucalypts at Clark's Rd and nested (KCH,SP). Coe's Ford, 8 on 22/4, 2 on 12/5 (KCH,SP). [OT] Rocklands Stn, Lammermoor Ra, 36 at 592 m asl on 26/10 (K&JVM). Middlemarch, 5 feeding in oat paddock with c.200 Spur-winged Plovers on 23/3. Maniototo, Blakeley's Dam, 2 with 6 Magpies (AW). Sandymount, Otago Pen, 2 on 6/4 (PS). Wairuna, rookery established in spring 1990, hundreds seen on 16/12 5 km away (MIT).
