

Reportable rare/unusual birds in New Zealand

The Records Appraisal Committee expects to receive reports of sightings of any species beyond their normal ranges (as depicted in Robertson et al. 2007. *Atlas of bird distribution in New Zealand 1999-2004*. Ornithological Society of New Zealand, Wellington). The list below is a general summary only. Sightings of escaped or released cage birds should not be submitted unless the observer believes them to have bred in the wild.
