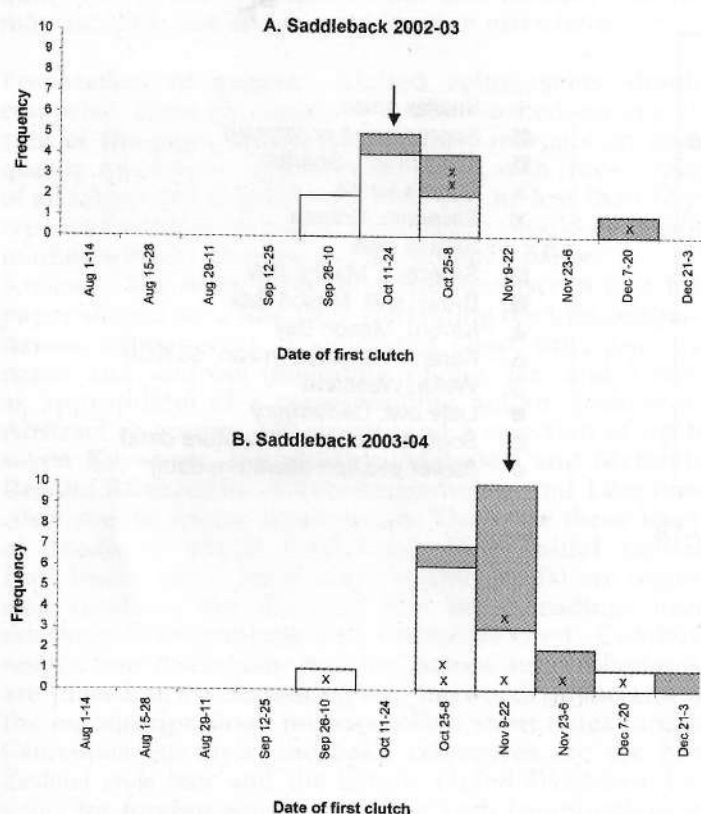


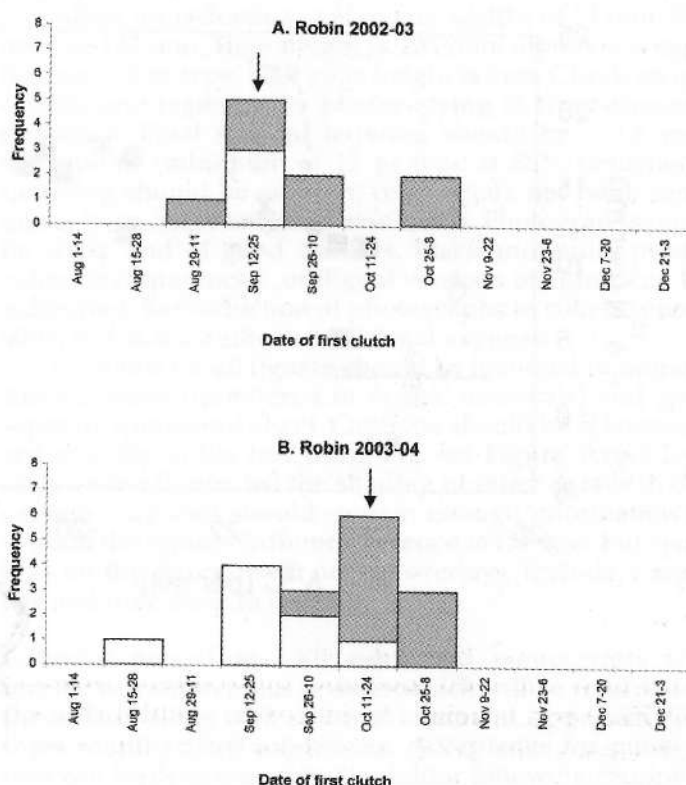
## CORRIGENDUM
